

Midget Blocks—Block 151

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of the blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a variety of prints, yellow solid and pink solid background fabric.

Feathered Star - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the ninth block from the left in the twelfth row.

This block is easiest to construct using a combination of hand or machine piecing and applique

The 1/4" seam allowance is NOT included on templates so they can be used for hand piecing. Add your seam allowance when cutting your fabric.

Pink solid

- Cut four A

Yellow solid

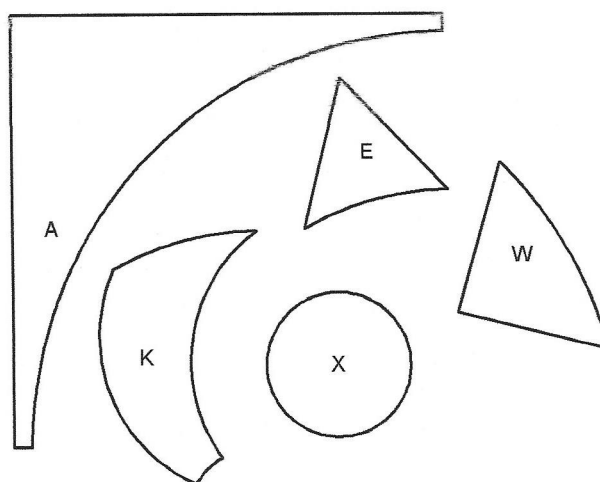
- Cut one X

Off-white solid

- Cut twelve W
- Cut six K

Assorted prints

- Cut six K
- Cut twelve E



Please read through the Assembly instructions before cutting your fabric to decide on the technique you want to use.

Assembly

This block is going to be a challenge. You can hand or machine piece it using the templates. Because I'm always looking for the easiest way, my suggestions are listed below. You can use all of them or maybe just one or two when making your block.

- Cut a 6" square of the pink solid for your background.
- Foundation paper piece the three E/W arcs and sew together forming a circle.
- Applique the circle on the background square
- Sew together the print and off-white K pieces to form a circle

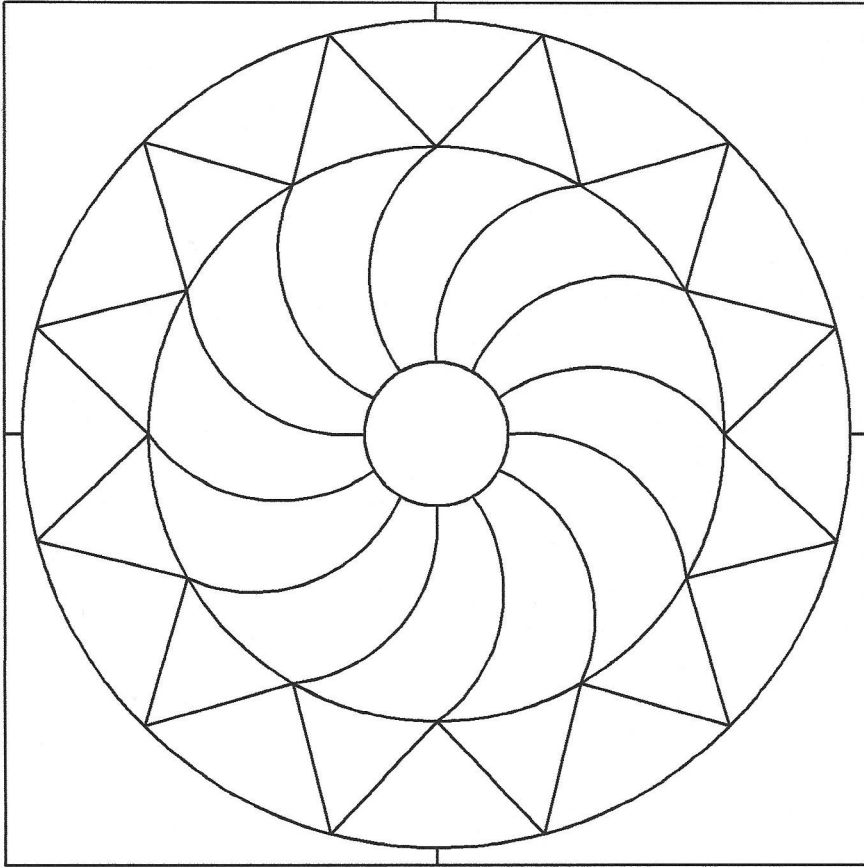

Feathered Star - 4 1/2"

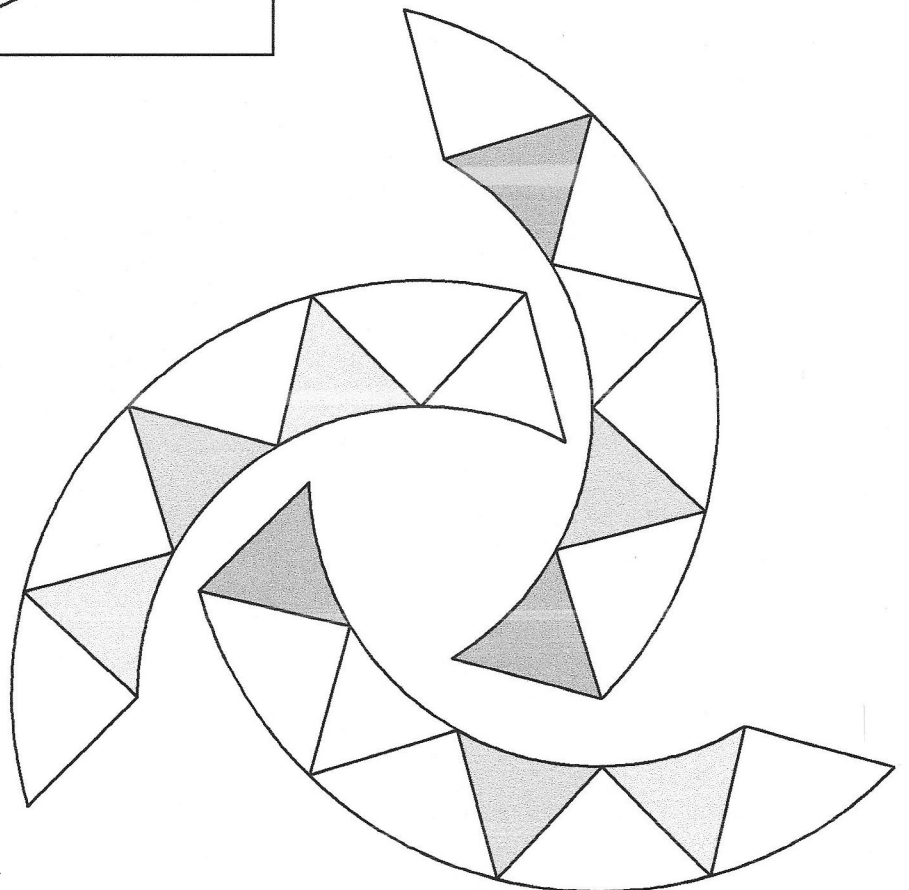
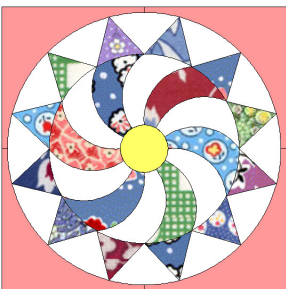


Assembly cont'

- Applique the complete K circle on the background square
- Applique the yellow X circle to the center completing the block
- Trim block to the 5" unfinished size.

Your unfinished block should measure 5"

measure 1" after
printing pattern.
