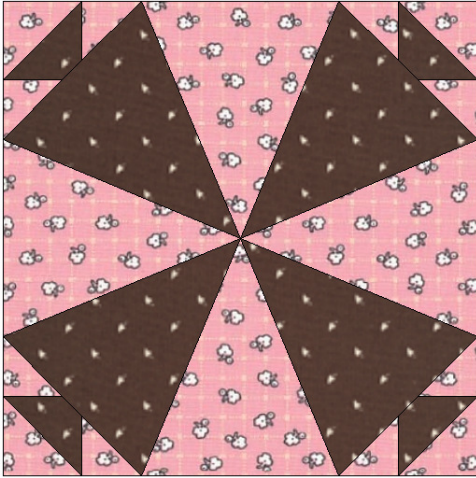


## Midget Blocks—Block 110

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own. Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using brown solid and the pink solid background fabric.



**Arrowhead - 4 1/2"**

**In the antique quilt this block is the second block from the left in the seventh row.**

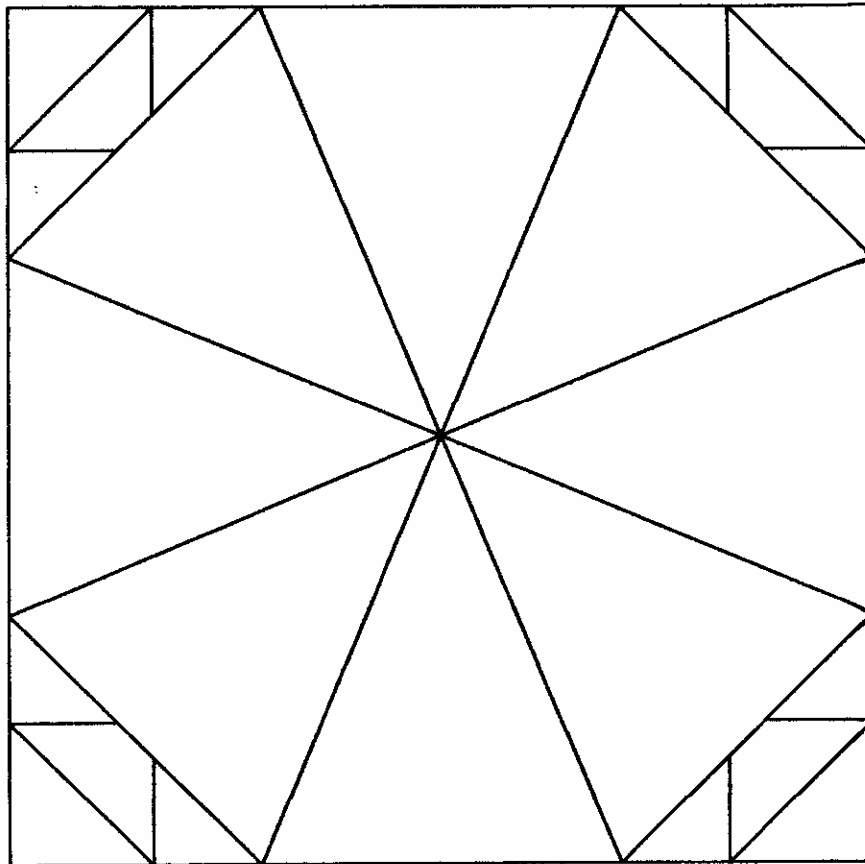
This block is well suited for applique

### **Background fabric—**

Cut one 6" square. Trim to 5" after your appliqué is completed

**Applique fabric —** scrap pieces

- Applique the block using your favorite hand or machine method



Your unfinished block should measure 5"



***Sentimental Stitches™***

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This line should  
measure 1" after  
printing pattern.
