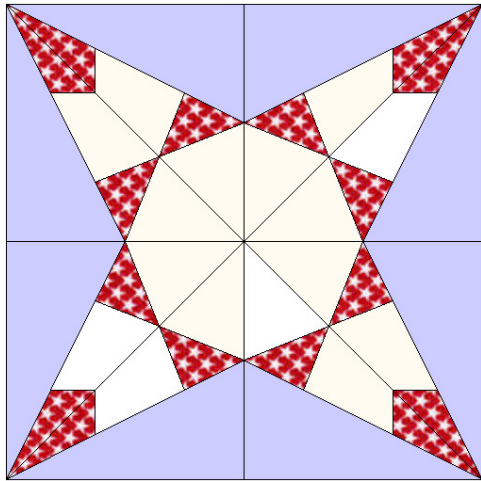


Midget Blocks—Block 123

This block in the original quilt was constructed using red and yellow solid on a blue background fabric.

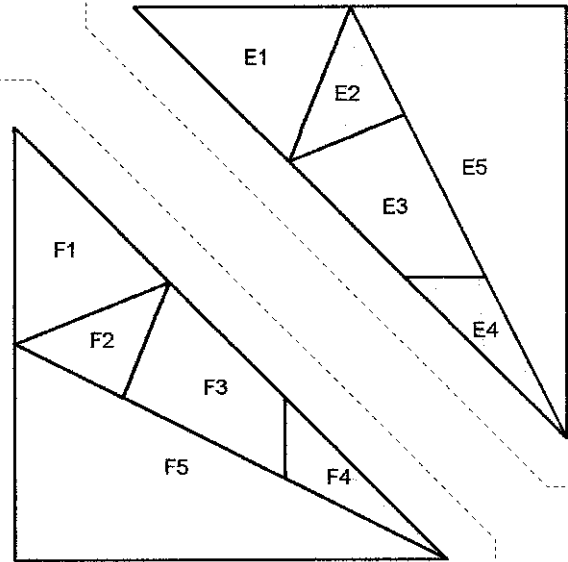
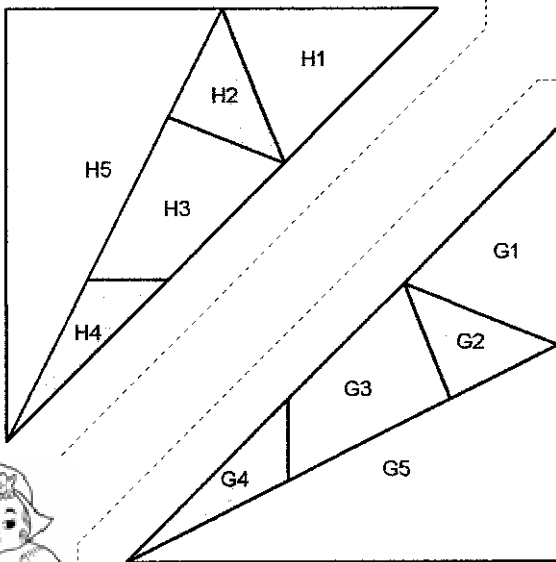
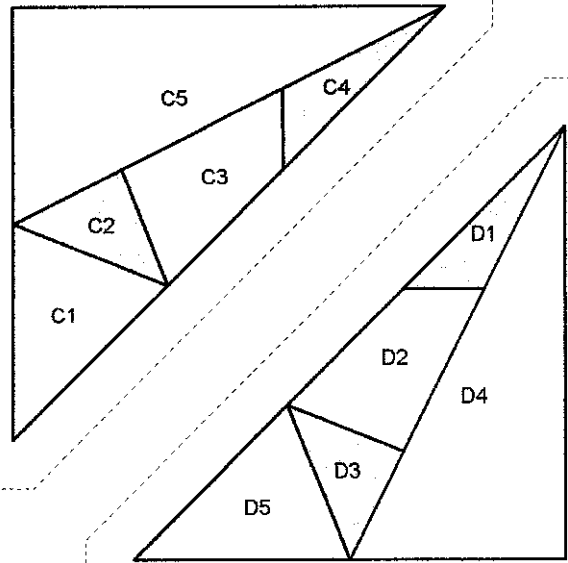
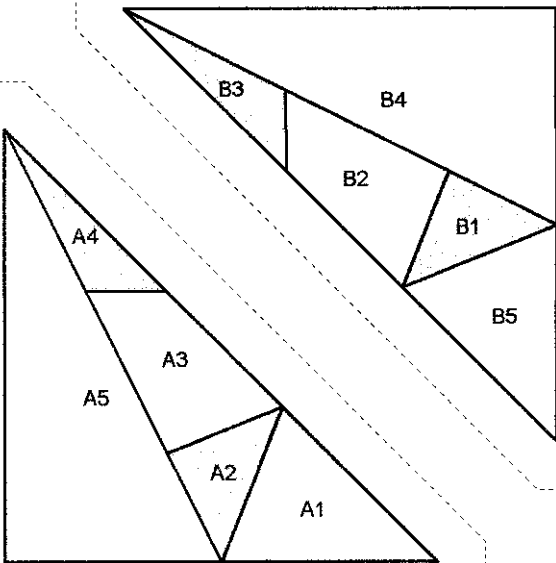


Logger's Star- 4 1/2"
