

Midget Blocks—Block 126



Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using purple solid and a purple print fabric.


Swastika-41/2"


In the antique quilt this block is the seventh block from the left in the eleventh row.


This block is well suited for foundation piecing
