

Midget Blocks—Block 128

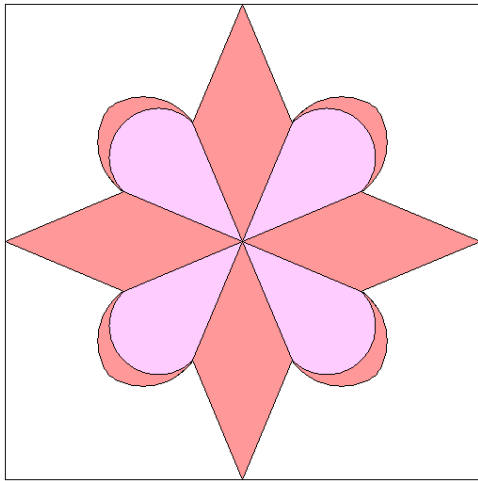
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.


Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using medium pink, light pink solid and the background fabric.

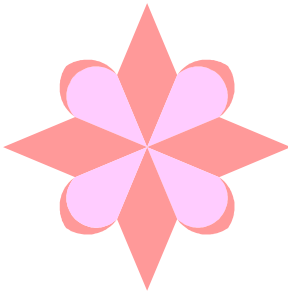
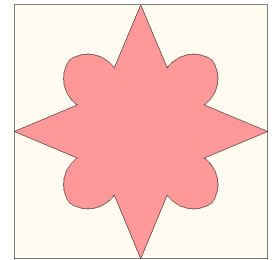
Four Winds 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the seventh block from the left in the thirteenth row.

This block is well suited for hand applique

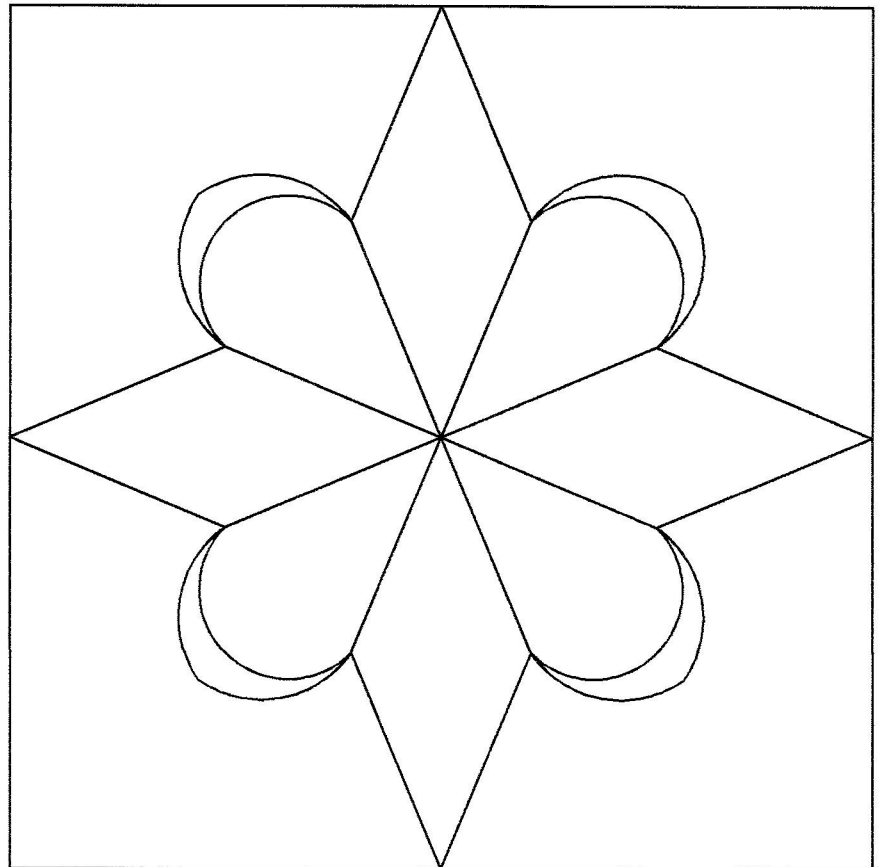


- Cut background square 6" (trim to 5" after completing your applique)
- Cut one 4" square of medium pink.
- Cut four inner cones of light pink. 
- It will be easier to applique the medium pink points and bottom cones in one piece.
- Applique the four light pink cones on top to complete the block.



Your unfinished block should measure 5"

This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.



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
