

Midget Blocks—Block 129

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

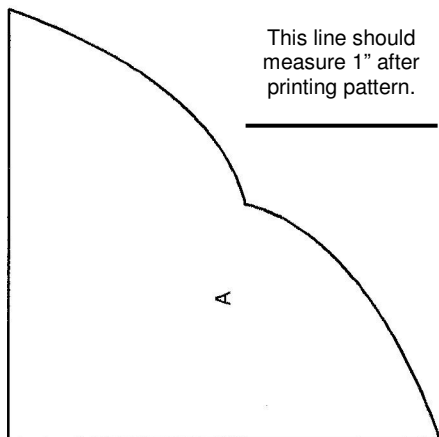
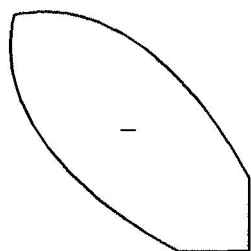
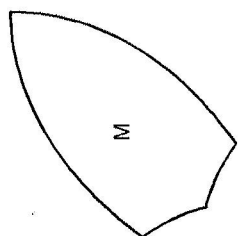
Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using medium pink, red print and the background fabric.

Springtime 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the tenth block from the left in the tenth row.

This block is well suited for hand applique

- Cut background square 6" (trim to 5" after completing your applique)
- Cut four "A" from medium pink.
- Cut four "I" from background.
- Cut four "M" from red print.
- Applique the four red "M" pieces to the center of the block.
- Applique the four medium pink "A" pieces to the corners of the block.
- Applique the four "I" pieces on top of the medium pink "A"



Your unfinished block should measure 5"
