

# Midget Blocks—Block 141

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a pink solid and off-white background fabric.

### Friendship Knot - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the second block from the left in the fifteenth row.

This block is well suited for hand piecing

## The 1/4" seam allowance IS NOT included on templates

#### **Background**

- Cut four A
- Cut four B
- Cut eight G
- Cut four I
- Cut one J

#### **Pink Solid**


- Cut eight C
- Cut eight D
- Cut one each of E—F—H—K

#### Assembly:

- No easy way to construct this block! I would begin by sewing the C and D diamonds together
  in pairs.
- Sew a G triangle to the top of each pair.
- Sew the pairs together so you have a cluster of diamonds.
- Sew a B triangle to the top of each cluster.
- Sew E—F—H—K arc to each side of background J



Sew a diamond cluster to each side of the arc unit.





# Assembly cont':


Sew the I pieces between the clusters.




 Sew the A triangles around the outside edge completing the block.
