

# Midget Blocks—Block 145

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a blue print, med. blue solid, purple print, purple solid, light red print, light blue solid and a green solid fabric

## Four Leaf Clover - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the eleventh block from the left in the fifteenth row.

This block is easiest to construct using a combination of machine piecing and applique

The 1/4" seam allowance is NOT included on templates so they can be used for hand piecing or applique. The seam allowance IS included in the rotary cutting measurements.

#### **Blue print**

• Cut eight 1 3/8" squares

#### **Medium Blue solid**

• Cut eight 1 1/8" x 1 3/8" rectangles

### **Purple print**

• Cut eight 1 3/8" squares

#### **Purple solid**

Cut eight 1 1/8" x 1 3/8" rectangles.

#### **Light Red print**


• Cut four 1 1/8" squares

#### **Light Blue solid**

Cut eight "C" for applique

#### Green solid

• Cut four A1 for applique



This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.

# Midget Blocks—Block 145

Four Leaf Clover - 4 1/2"

### Assembly:

It's easiest to construct this block by making four uneven Nine Patch blocks. Make two using
the blue fabric and two using the purple fabrics. The light background red print is in the center
on both color blocks.












· Sew the blocks together as shown.



• Applique green solid A1 shapes over the vertical and horizontal seam lines.



• Applique light blue C shapes around the outside edge of the block.
