

Midget Blocks—Block 147

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a green print, green solid, pink solid and an off-white solid fabric

Flowering Nine Patch - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the seventh row.

This block is easiest to construct using hand or machine piecing

The 1/4" seam allowance is NOT included on templates so they can be used for hand piecing. Add your seam allowance when cutting your fabric.

Any rotary cutting measurements INCLUDE the 1/4" seam allowance

Green print

• Cut four C and four C (reversed)

Pink solid


Cut four A or rotary cut four 1 1/8" squares.

Off-white solid

Cut four D

Green solid

- Cut nine A or rotary cut nine 1 1/8" squares.
- Cut eight B



Midget Blocks—Block 147


Flowering Nine Patch - 4 1/2"

Assembly


Sew five green A and four pink A squares together as a Nine Patch block.




• Sew a green B triangle to two sides of off-white D pieces.




• Sew a green print C to each side of B/D unit.



• Sew one of the B/C/D units to each side of the center nine patch block



Sew a green A square in each corner completing the block.
