

## Midget Blocks—Block 160

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of the blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using two blue and white prints, a red print and blue solid background fabric.

### Rocky Road West - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the second row.

*This block can be constructed using a variety of techniques. Please read assembly instructions before cutting your fabric to decide on the technique you'd like to use.*

The 1/4" seam allowance is NOT included on templates. Add your seam allowance when cutting your fabric for hand or machine piecing.

#### Blue print 1

- Cut four D

#### Blue print 2

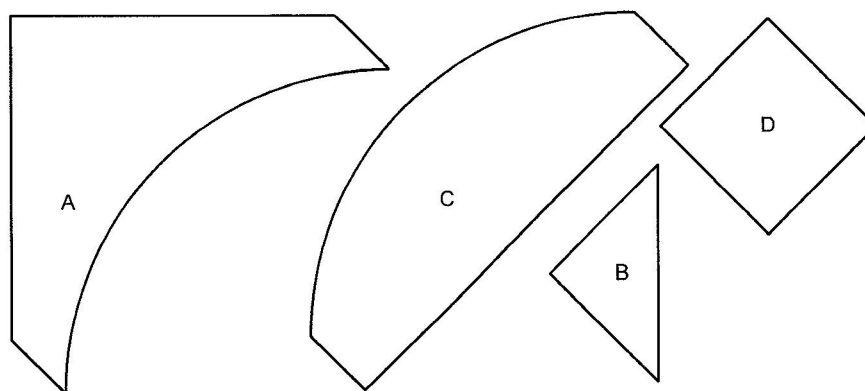
- Cut four C

#### Red print

- Cut five D
- Cut four B

#### Blue solid

- Cut four A



#### Assembly

- The traditional assembly of this block would be to cut fabric pieces using the templates above and hand or machine piecing the block. If that's not what you'd like to do, there's also a full size block drawing included in this pattern.

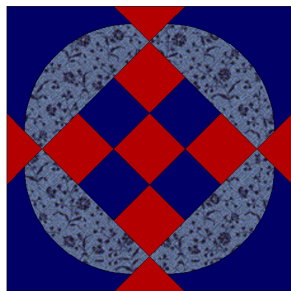


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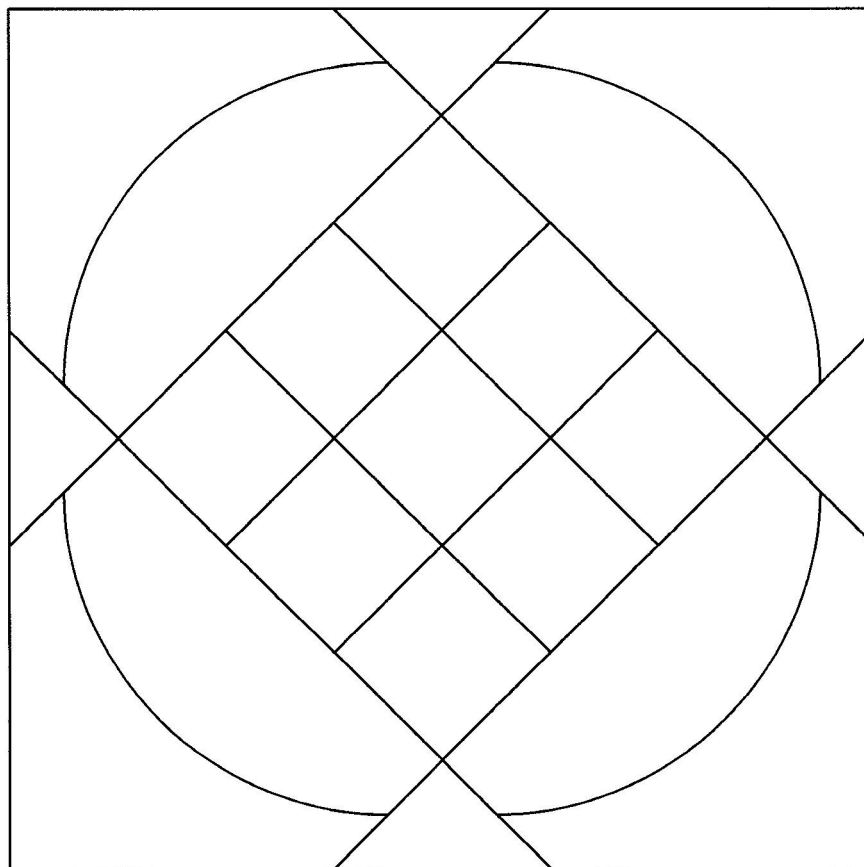
This line should
