

Midget Blocks—Block 90

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using an green solid, peach solid and a green print fabric.

I chose to substitute a yellow solid for the peach in my block.

Sea Star—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the eleventh row.

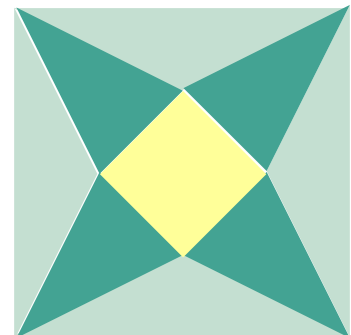
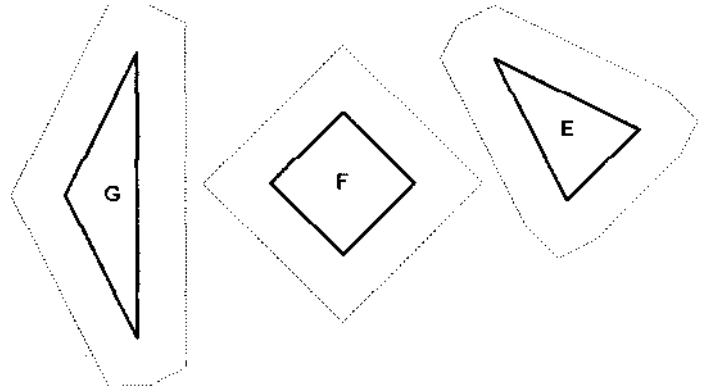
This block is well suited for hand and foundation piecing.

For hand piecing:

- From yellow solid cut one "F" square.
- From green solid cut four "E" points.
- From green print cut four "G" pieces.

Stitching center section:

- ♦ Sew an "E" piece to each side of yellow square.
- ♦ Sew the "G" pieces around the "E" green solid points to complete the center section.

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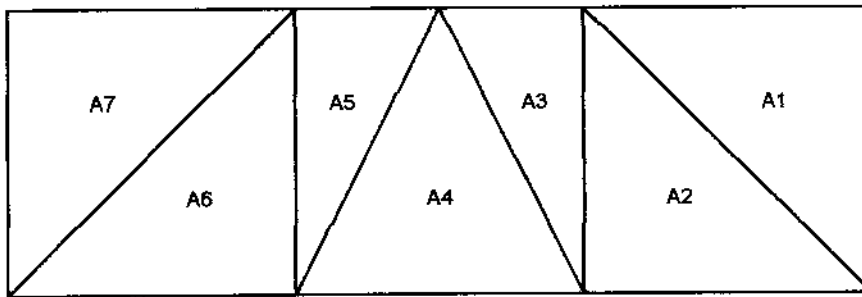
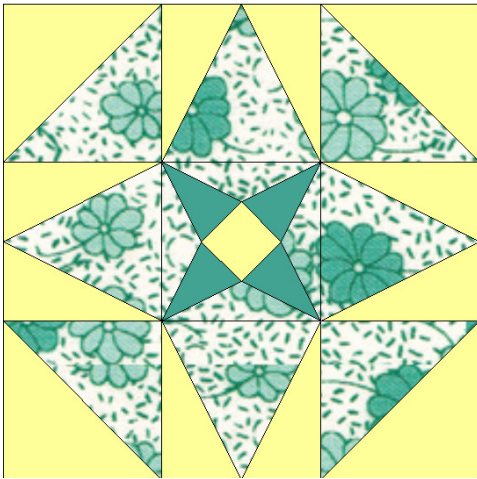
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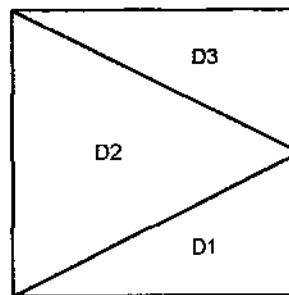
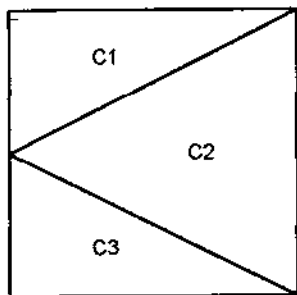
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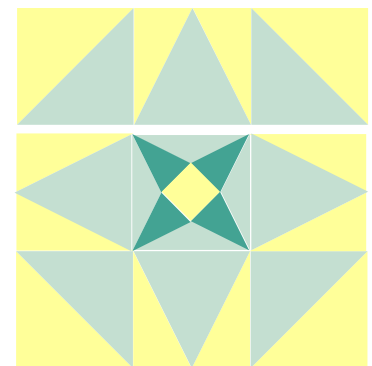
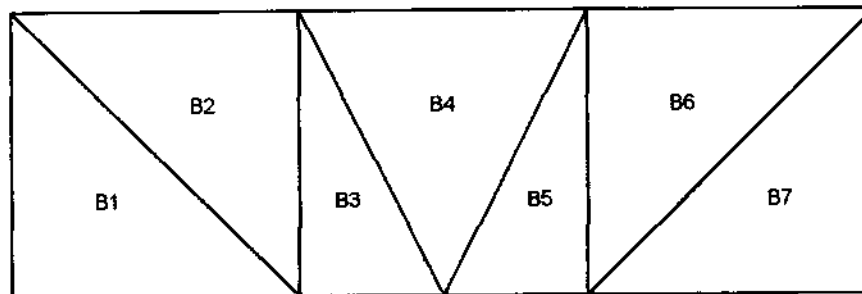


For foundation piecing section:

- Foundation piece one of section "C" and one of section "D".
- Sew the "C" and "D" to each side of the hand pieced center.



- Foundation piece one of section "A" and one of section "B".
- Sew the A and B to each side of the center strip to complete the block.



Your unfinished block should measure 5"

This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.

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
