

Midget Blocks—Block 91

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using an red solid and a light orange solid fabric.

Blazing Star—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the tenth block from the left in the fourth row.

This block is well suited for foundation piecing.

Foundation piece one each of sections "A " - "C" - "E" and "G". ***



*** the foundation pattern is reversed so colors will be in the correct position after they are sewn.


Foundation piece one each of sections "B" - "D" - "F" and "H".




Sew B to C, D to E, F to G and H to A forming four squares.



Sew squares together as shown below.






This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.
