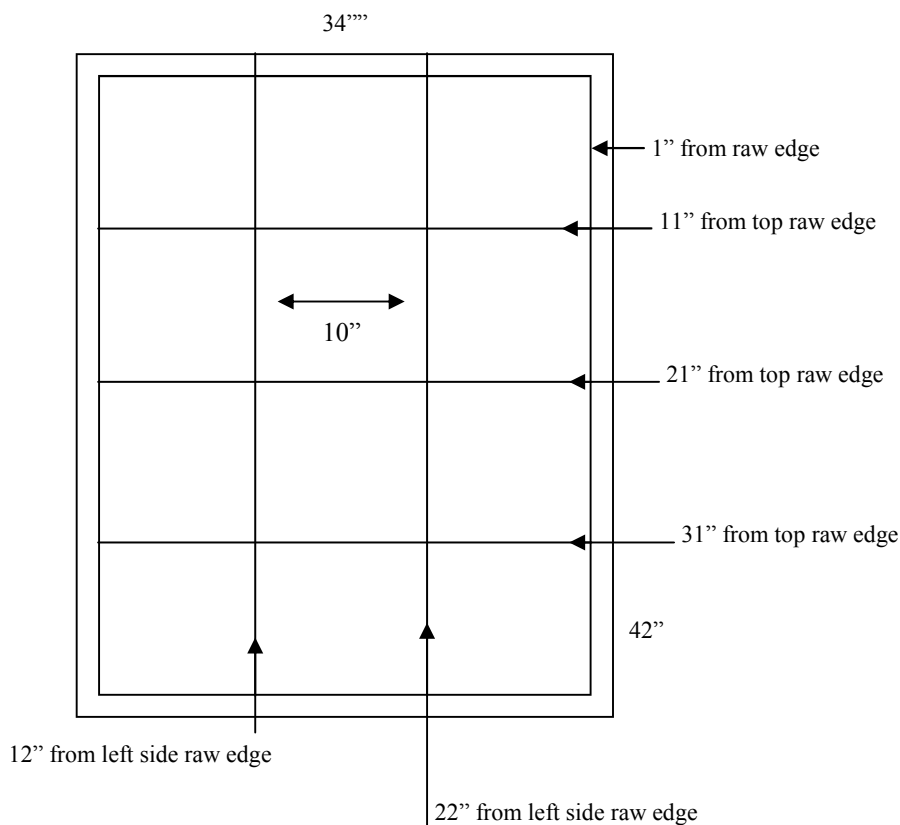


Just For Baby Block 1

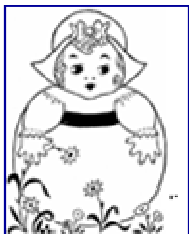


The finished size of the quilt is 32" x 41". It has a gentle scalloped edge and divisions between the blocks. You'll need to purchase 1 yard of background fabric of your choice. All of the appliqué is done in solid color fabrics. You'll need 1 1/2 yards of red and 1/2 yard each of blue, light blue, yellow, pink and green. Backing—1 1/4 yards. Black embroidery floss. Crib size batting. Basic quilting supplies.

- To prepare background fabric cut a piece 34" x 42"
- Using a fine line washout marking pen, mark your background fabric as shown below
- Using a contrast color thread, baste along marked lines. Remove blue marking lines. Be sure not to leave the blue pen lines on your fabric too long or iron them. They may not come out.
- You now have 12—10" blocks marked on your background fabric.
- We'll be starting our blocks in the upper left hand corner.



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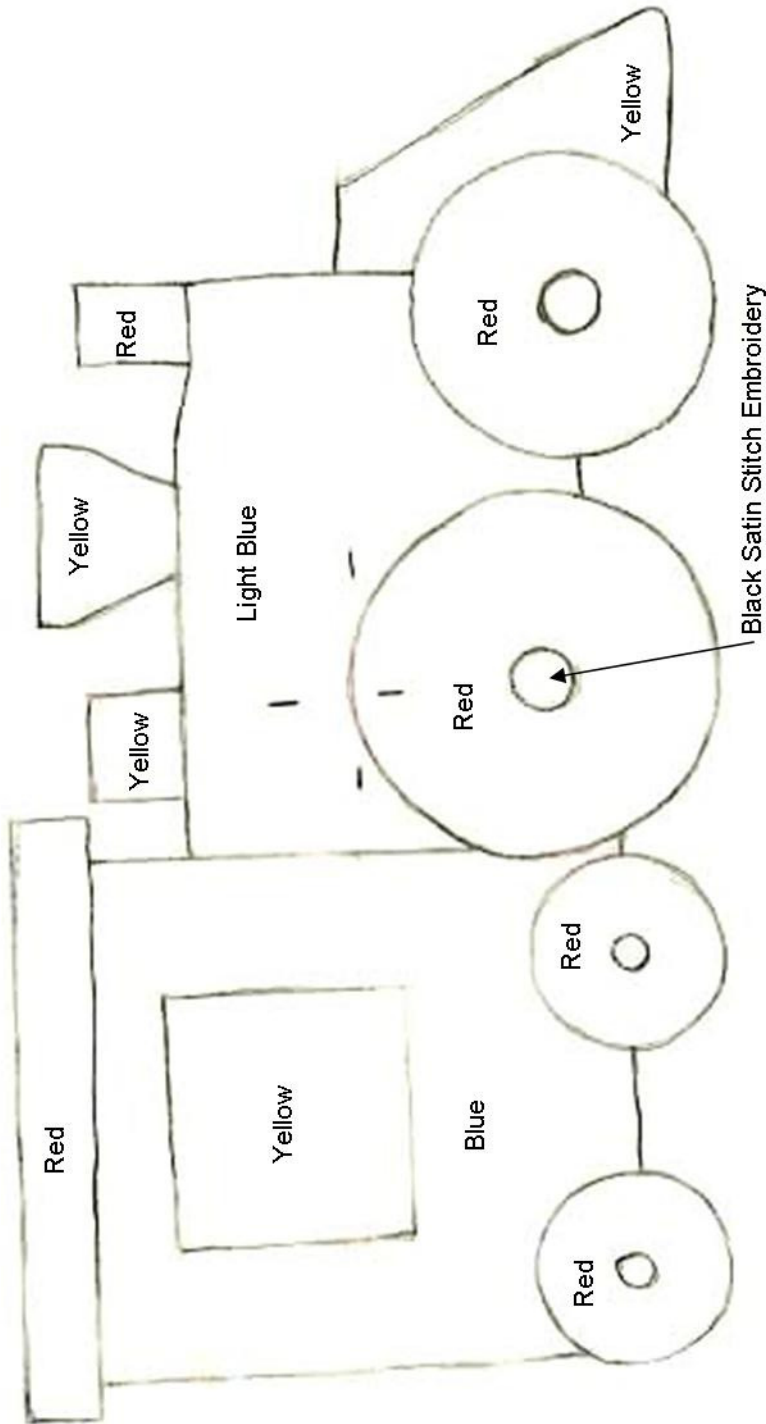


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Just For Baby Block 1



- Using your favorite method, appliqué Block 1 in the upper left corner 10" square centering the design within the square.
- Applique colors are marked on the pattern.
- Note the black satin stitch embroidery centers on the train wheels.
- I might embroider a little curly smoke coming out of the center yellow smoke stack.



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
