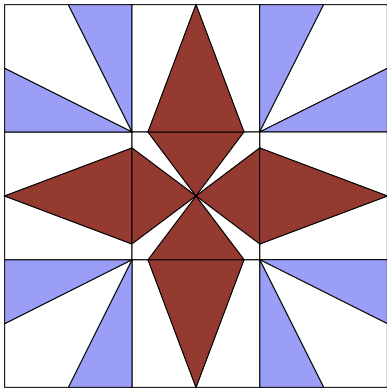


# Midget Blocks—Block 25



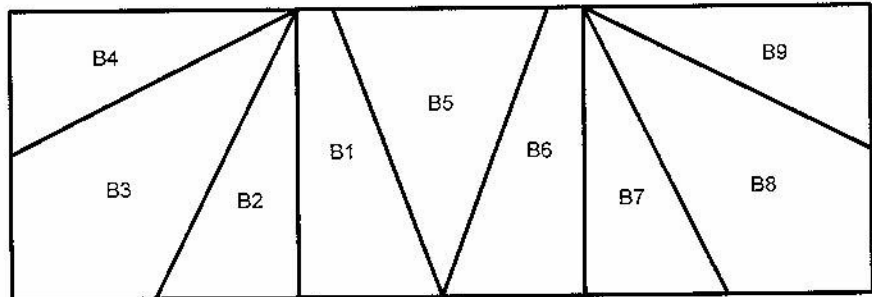
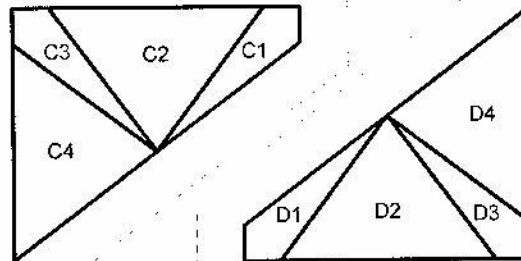
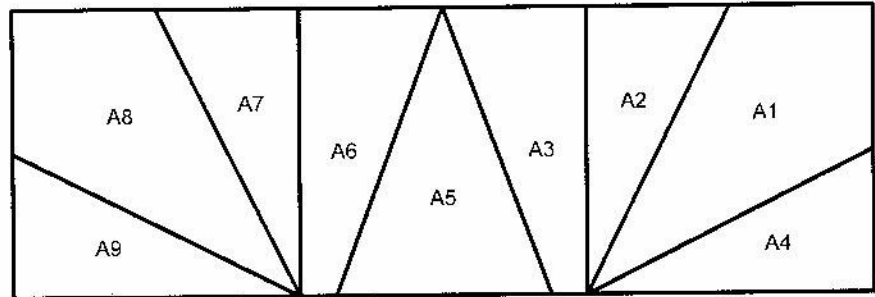
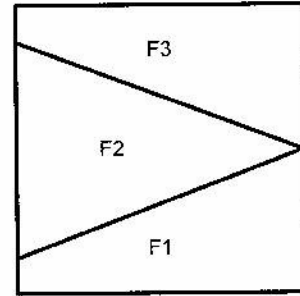
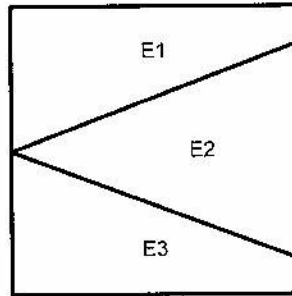
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using red, blue and the background fabric.

## Guiding Star 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the seventh block from the left in the ninth row.

This block is the easiest to construct if you use a foundation paper piecing pattern.
