

Midget Blocks—Block 26

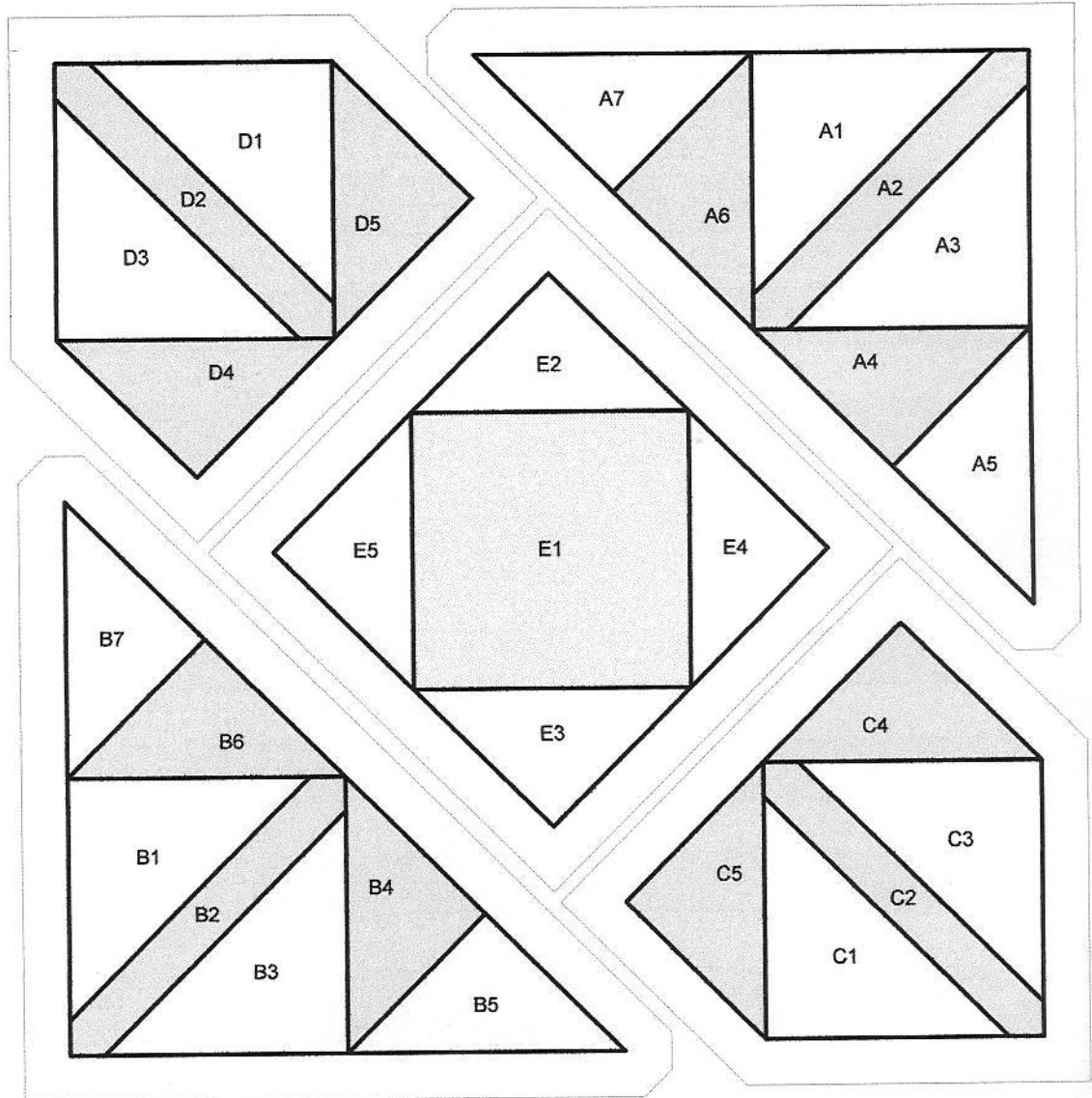
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using two shades of purple and the background fabric.

Old Snowflake 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the fourth block from the left in the tenth row.

This block is the easiest to construct if you use a foundation paper piecing pattern.
