
Blue Lake Lap Quilt. 54" x 61"



Materials

Light Yellow: 7/8 yard
Blue & Yellow: 5/8 yard
Blue Print: 1/2 yard
Light Blue Floral: 5/8 yard
Medium Blue Floral: 5/8 yard
Outer Border & Binding: 2 yards
Backing: 3 1/2 yards





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Blue Lake Lap Quilt.

54" x 61"

Cutting:

1/4" seam allowance is included in all measurements

Strip Sets:

Cut 3 strips 2 1/4" wide x the width of your fabric from light yellow

Cut 3 strips 2 1/4" wide x the width of your fabric from blue & yellow print

Cut 6 strips 2 1/4" wide x the width of your fabric from blue print.

Rectangles:

Cut 21 rectangles 2 1/4" x 4" from light yellow

Cut 21 rectangles 2 1/4" x 4" from blue & yellow print

Large Squares:

Cut 21 squares 4" from light blue floral

Cut 21 squares 4" from medium blue floral

<u>Inner Border:</u>

Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" x 49 1/2" for the sides. *

Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" for the top and bottom. *

Outer Border:

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x 51 1/2" for the sides. *

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x 54 1/2" for the top and bottom. *

Binding Fabric:

Cut 7 strips 2 1/4" wide x the width of your fabric

Backing Fabric:

Cut the 3 1/2 yard piece in half so you have two pieces about 45" x 62". Sew sections together selvage to selvage so it measures approximately 63" x 90"

- 1. Sew together in pairs, the light yellow strips and blue print strips. Sew the blue and yellow print strips to the remaining blue print strips. Press seams to one side.
- 2. From each color group of strip units, cut 21 pieces 2 1/4" wide.
- 3. Sew a corresponding light yellow or blue and yellow rectangle to one side of the piece cut from the strip units.
- 4. Complete the blocks by adding the light blue floral and medium blue floral large squares to make 21 blocks of each color arrangement.
- 5. Set the blocks together in seven rows of six blocks each, alternating between the two color arrangements. Refer to the quilt illustration for block placement.
- 6. Sew inner border to the blocks, sewing the side strips first, then the top and bottom.
- 7. Sew outer border to the guilt top, sewing the side strips first, then the top and bottom.

* Measure your quilt top down the center vertically and horizontally before cutting the length of your border strips. You want to make sure they are cut to match your center section.
