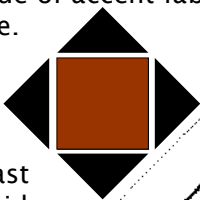


# SHIPSHEWANA AMISH QUILT

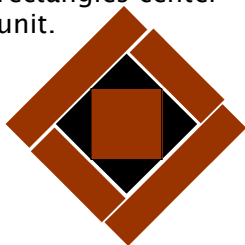
## Section 7



Sew a  $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " background triangle to each side of accent fabric  $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " square.



Sew the contrast fabric  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " wide rectangles center unit.



### Cutting:

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance is included in all cutting measurements.  
Finished size of block—9"

#### Background fabric-

- Cut one  $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " square and cut diagonally both ways to yield 4 triangles
- Cut one strip  $1 \frac{7}{8}$ " wide x width of fabric. From this strip cut 2 each of templates "A" - "B" - "C" and "D".

Sew an "A" and "D" background piece to the 2 short sides of 2 of the accent triangles cut from the  $2 \frac{5}{8}$ " square.



#### Contrasting fabric-

- Cut two rectangles  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x  $6 \frac{7}{8}$ "
- Cut two rectangles  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4 \frac{3}{8}$ "
- Cut two  $2 \frac{5}{8}$ " squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles
- Cut one  $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " square



Sew a "B" and "C" background rectangle to the 2 short sides of remaining accent triangles cut from the  $2 \frac{5}{8}$ " squares.



Cut two  $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares from each color. Sub-cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles. Sew opposite colors together along the long edge to yield 4 half square triangles. Sew together in a strip as shown..



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
