

## Midget Blocks—Block 61

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a purple solid, lavender solid and the background fabric.


## Royal Star 4's-4 1/2"


In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the ninth row.


This block is well suited for foundation paper piecing.


- 1. Foundation paper piece each section referring to the color illustration of the block for fabric placement.
- 2. Sew the triangular sections together first in pairs, then halves and complete the block by sewing the halves together.

Your unfinished block should measure 5"
