

Midget Blocks—Block 61

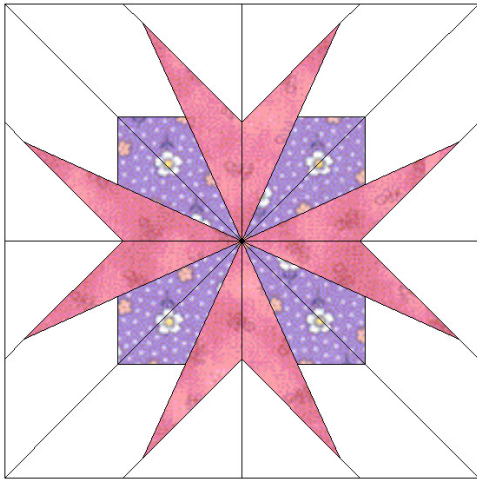
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a purple solid, lavender solid and the background fabric.

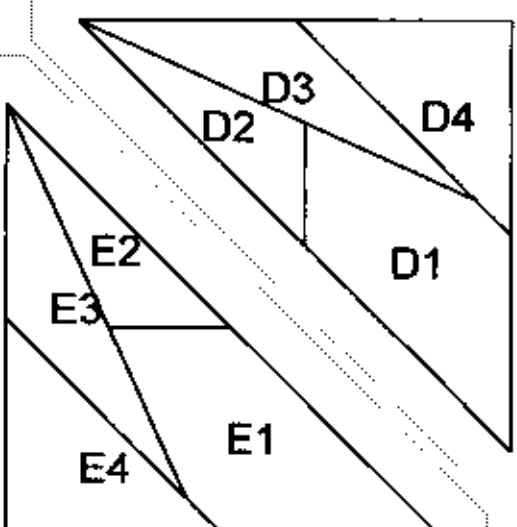
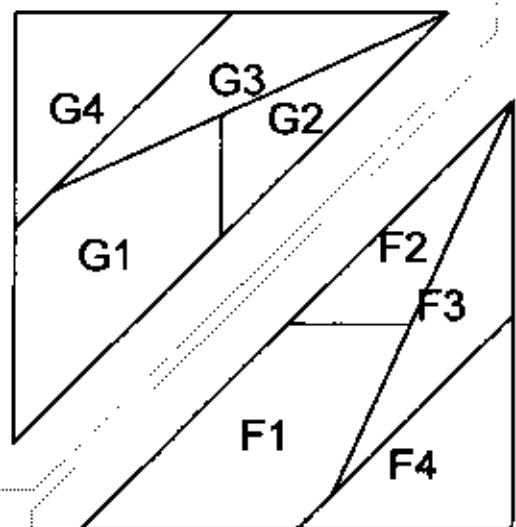
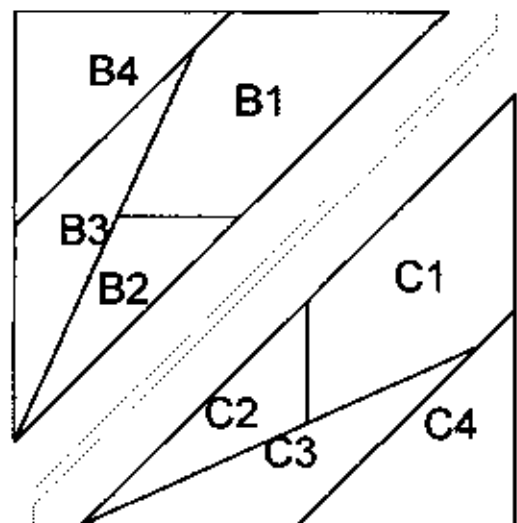
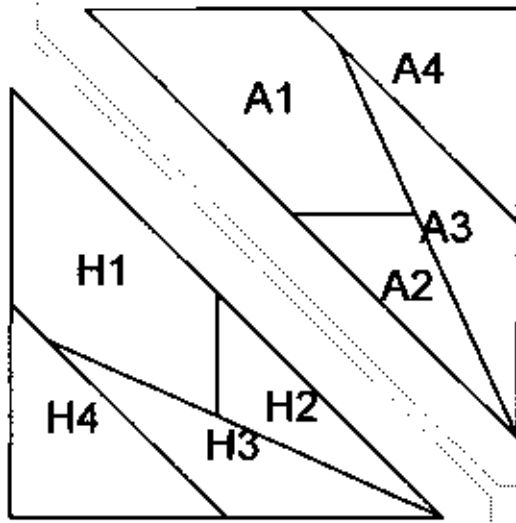
Royal Star 4's—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the ninth row.

This block is well suited for foundation paper piecing.



1. Foundation paper piece each section referring to the color illustration of the block for fabric placement.
2. Sew the triangular sections together first in pairs, then halves and complete the block by sewing the halves together.



Your unfinished block should measure 5"
