

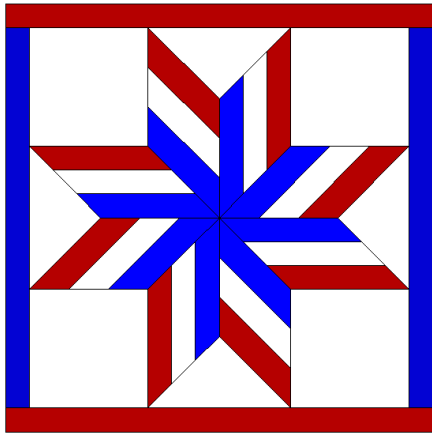
## Midget Blocks—Block 62

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

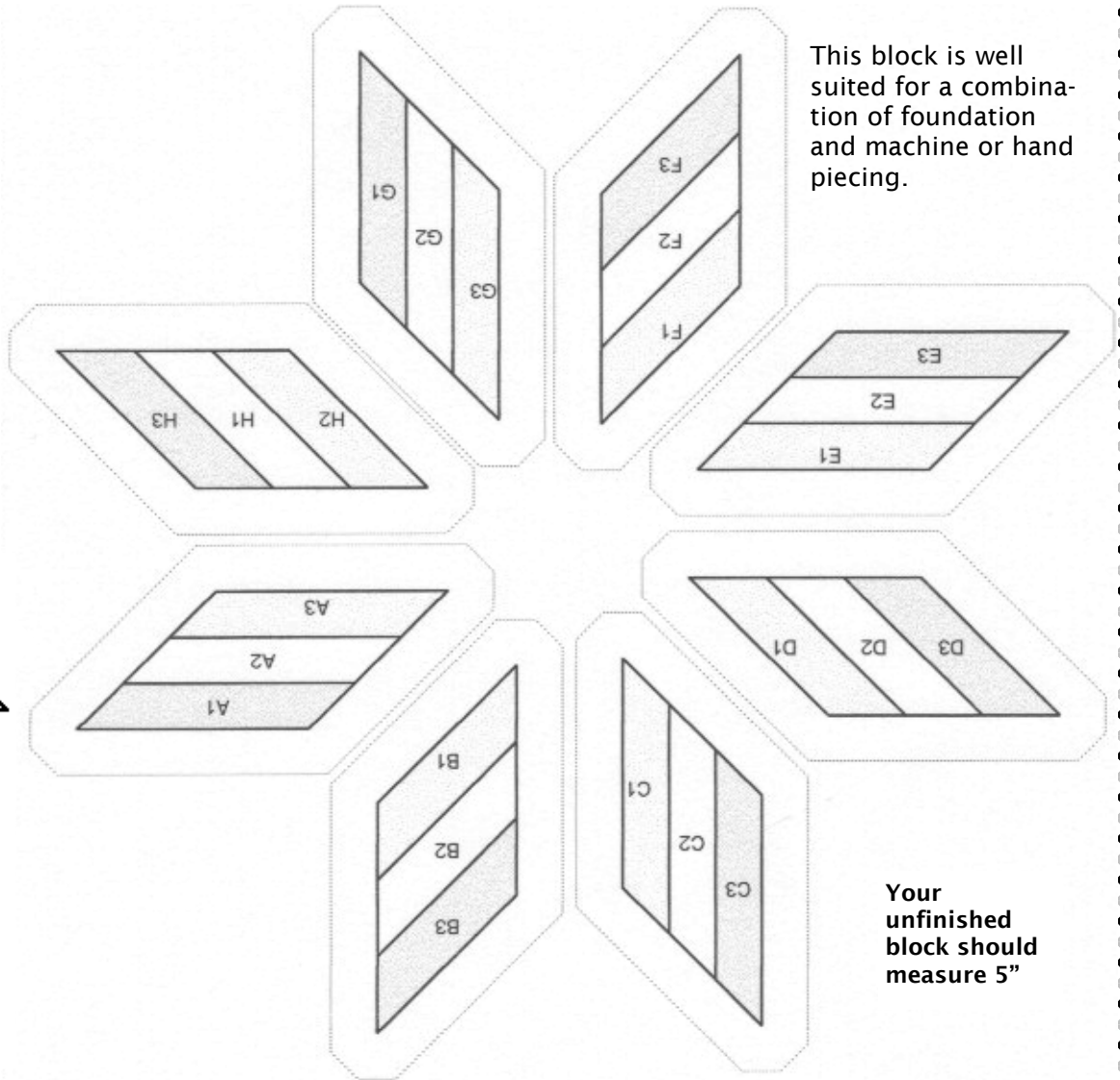
Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a red solid, blue solid and the background fabric.

### Liberty Star—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the fifth block from the left in the fourth row.

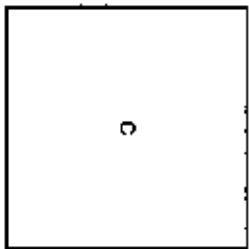
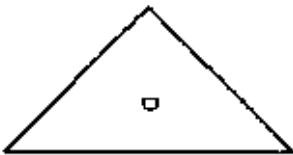


1. For accurate pieced diamonds, use the foundation paper pieces to construct each diamond.
2. The corner squares and triangles can be rotary cut if you want to machine piece them and templates are provided if you'd like to hand piece them.
3. Rotary cutting:  
Squares are 1 3/4" - Triangles cut one square 2 3/4" and cut diagonally both ways to yield four triangles. Cut two blue strips 3/4" x 4 1/2". Cut two red strips 3/4" x 5".
4. Hand piecing: use the square and triangle templates pictured below and cut four squares and four triangles. You'll need to rotary cut the red and blue strips.



This block is well suited for a combination of foundation and machine or hand piecing.

Your unfinished block should measure 5"



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
