

Midget Blocks—Block 68

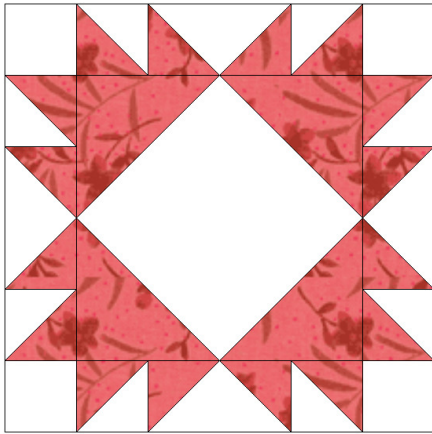
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a red solid and the background fabric.

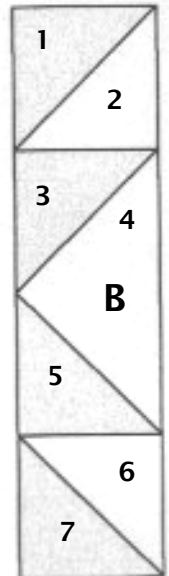
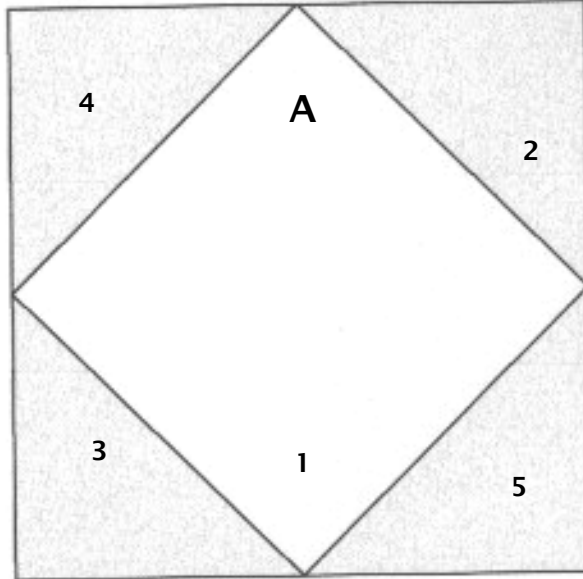
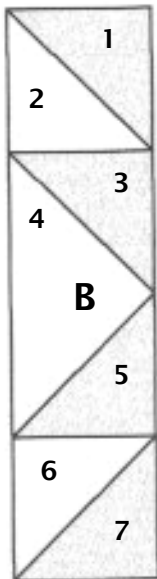
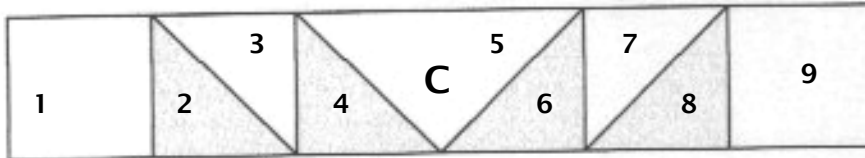
Mosaic—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the seventh block from the left in the fifteenth.

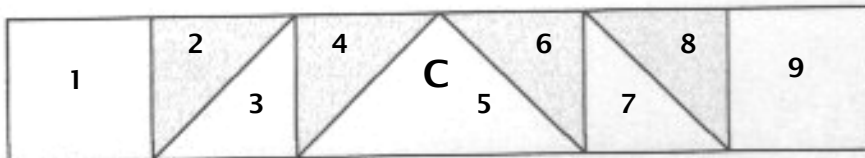
This block is well suited for foundation paper piecing.



1. Foundation paper piece one section "A", two section "B" and two section "C"
2. Sew a section "B" to opposite sides of section "A"
3. Sew a section "C" to the remaining sides of section "A" to complete the block.



Your unfinished block should measure 5"
