

## Midget Blocks—Block 71

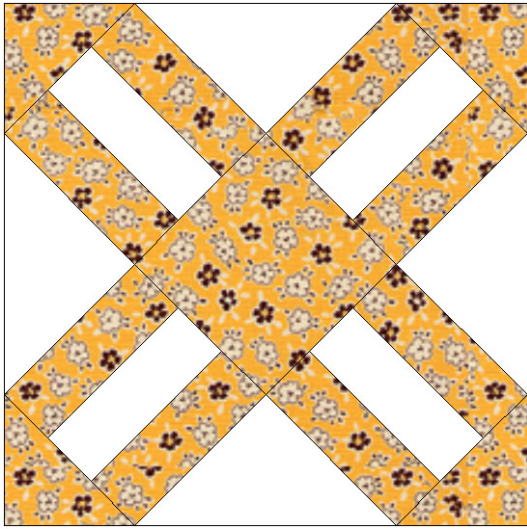
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a green solid and background fabric.

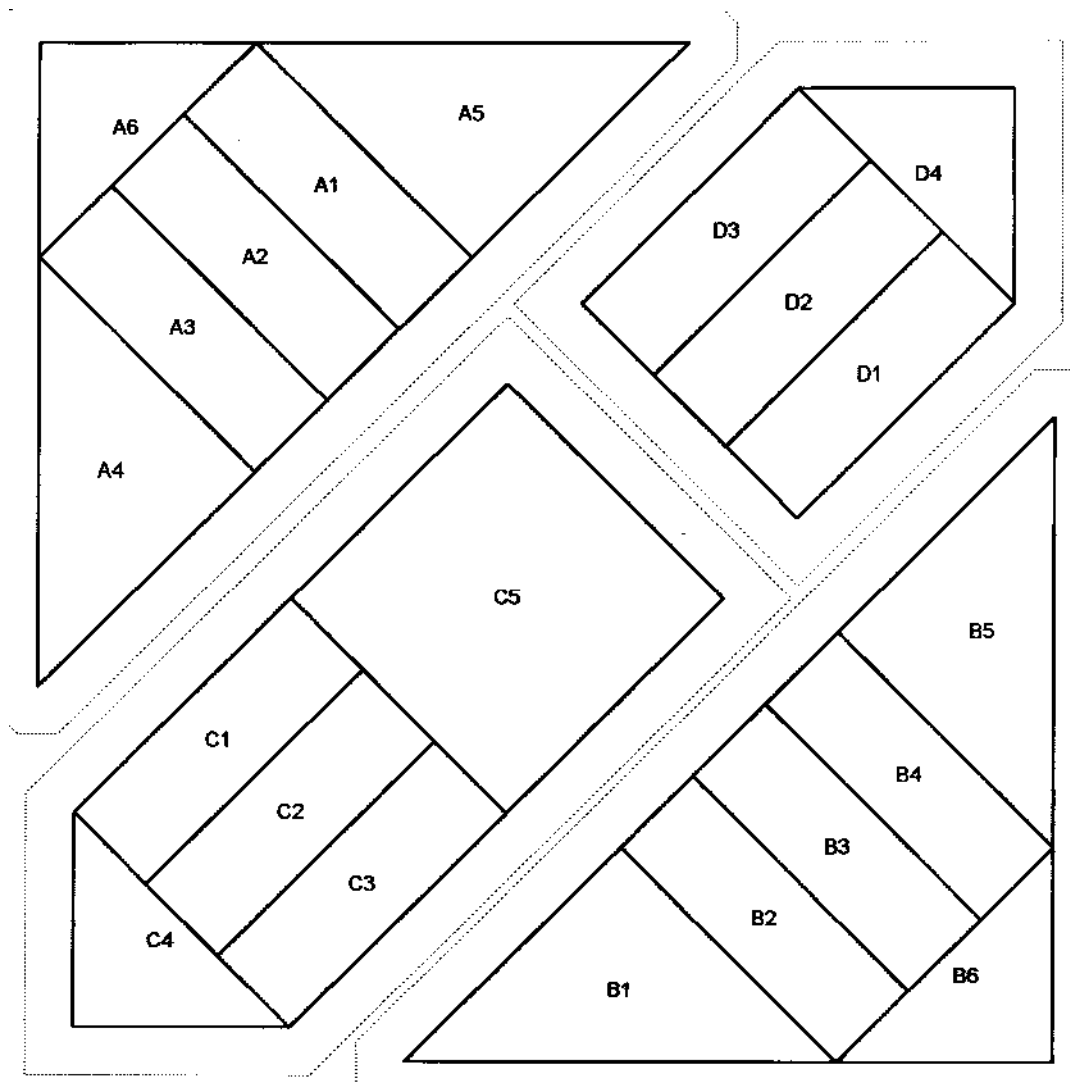
### Railroad Crossing—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the first row.

This block is well suited for foundation paper piecing.



1. This block is quick and easy to complete.
2. Choose one of your favorite prints and your background fabric.
3. Foundation piece the four sections needed for the block.
4. Sew C and D sections together for the center diagonal strip.
5. Sew an A section to one side and a B section to the opposite side of the center strip to complete the block



Your unfinished block should measure 5"
