

## Midget Blocks—Block 73

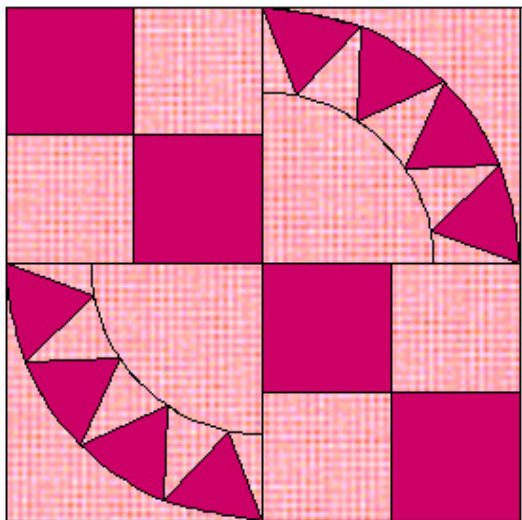
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a light pink solid and a dark pink solid.

### Dogwood—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the fifth block from the left in the ninth row.

This block is well suited for a combination of machine, foundation piecing and appliqué.



#### From light pink fabric cut:

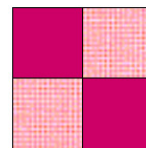
Cut four 1 5/8" squares

Cut two 2 3/4" squares

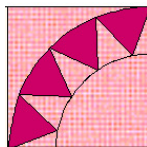
#### From dark pink fabric cut:

Cut four 1 5/8" squares

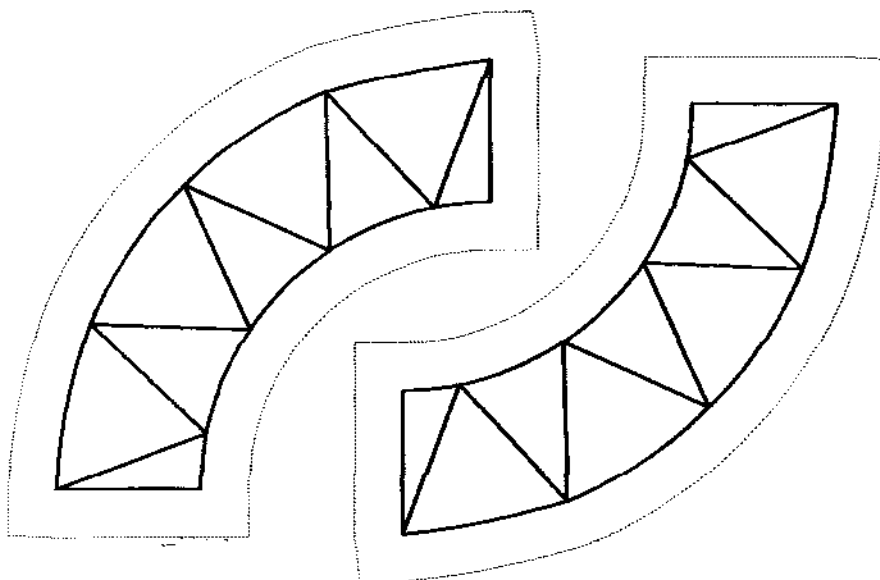
- Sew together the 1 5/8" squares into two little four patch blocks.



- Foundation piece two of the dogwood petal arcs.
- Applique the arcs to the 2 3/4" squares.



- Sew the four patch and arc units together to complete the blocks



Your unfinished block should measure 5"



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
