

## Midget Blocks—Block 74

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a light blue solid, dark blue print, red print and background fabric.

**Bride—4 1/2"**

**In the antique quilt this block is the eighth block from the left in the ninth row.**

This block is well suited for appliqué.

**From background fabric:**

Cut one 5" square

**From dark blue fabric:**

Cut four "A" triangles

Cut one "F" square

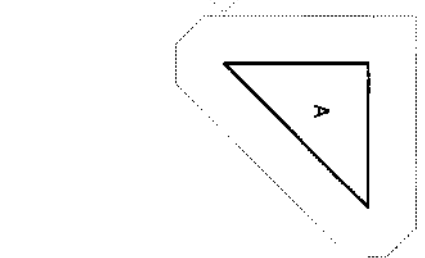
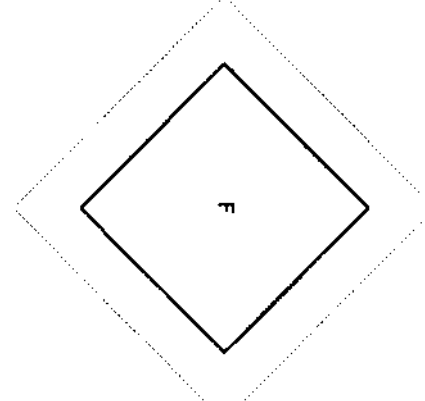
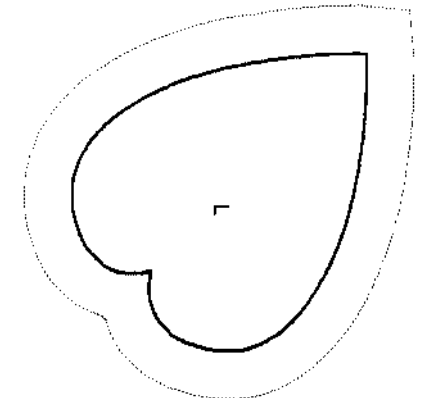
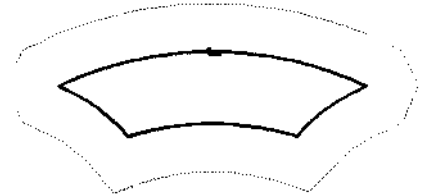
**From red print fabric:**

Cut four "L" hearts

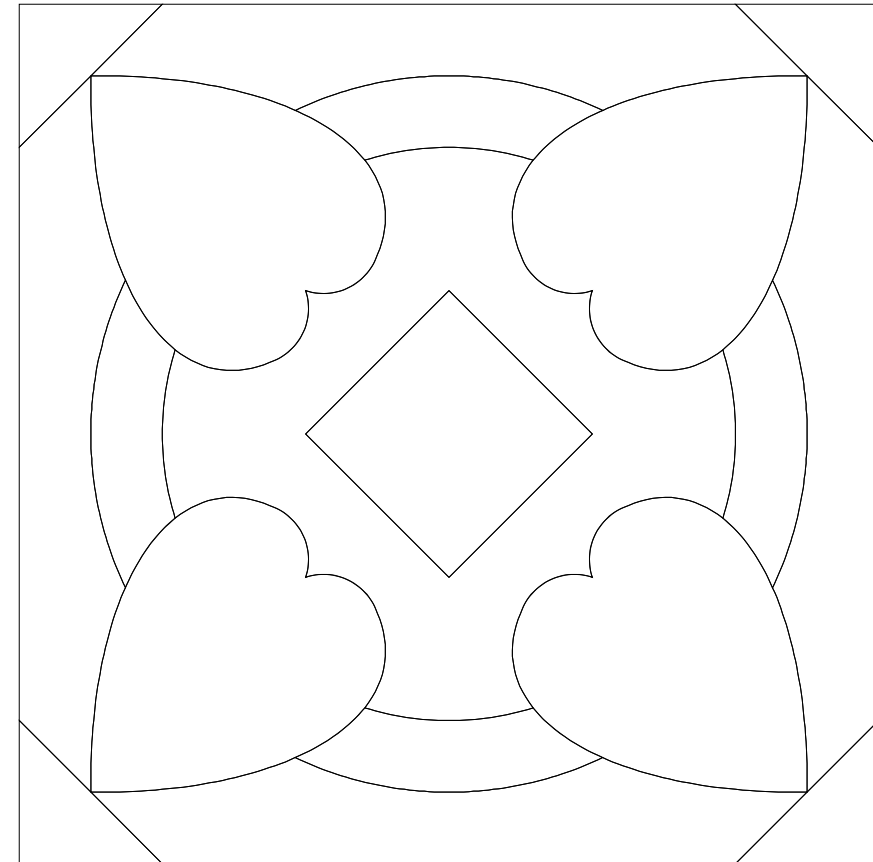
**From light blue solid fabric:**

Cut four arcs

- Appliqué a dark blue triangle to each corner of background square.
- Appliqué dark blue square to center of background square.
- Appliqué a light blue arc matching position to full size block drawing.
- Complete the block by appliquéing the four red hearts.



Your unfinished block should measure 5"
