

SHIPSHEWANA AMISH QUILT

Section 3

Cutting for Basket Blocks:

Background fabric-

Cut eight 3 1/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 16 triangles.

Cut four rectangles 2 3/4" x 5"

Cut one 5 3/8" square and cut diagonally one way to yield 2 triangles.

Basket fabric-

Cut two 3 1/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles.

Cut one 5 3/8" square and cut diagonally one way to yield 2 triangles.

Light fabric-

Cut one 3 1/8" square and cut diagonally one way to yield 2 triangles.

Medium fabric-

Cut two 3 1/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles.

Dark fabric-

Cut two 3 1/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles.

Compliment fabric-

Cut one 3 1/8" square and cut diagonally one way to yield 2 triangles.

Accent fabric-

Cut one 5 1/4" square and cut diagonally both ways to yield 4 triangles.

Piecing of Blocks:

- Using the 3 1/8" background triangles and light, medium, dark and compliment triangles; sew right sides together along the long edge to form half square triangle units. Press seams toward the background fabric.



- Sew half square triangle units together in rows mixing up colors to be visually pleasing..



- Sew a background triangle to the ends of the two unit half square triangle strip and the single half square triangle unit.



- Sew these rows together.

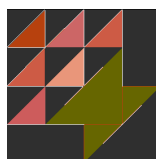
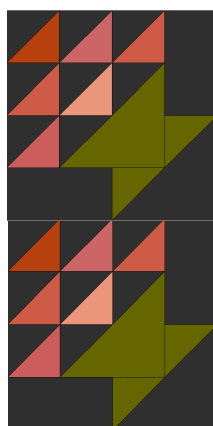
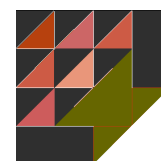


- Sew the large basket triangle to the half square triangle section to form a square.



- Sew a small basket triangle to the end of the two background rectangles for the basket base units.

- Sew a basket base unit to each side of the basket square section.
- Complete block by sewing the large background triangle to the bottom of the basket.
- Repeat for a second block.
