

## Materials

Background fabric— 3/4 yard

Sashing, outer border corner squares & blocks - 3/8 yard

Inner border & blocks — 1 1/8 yards

Outer border & blocks— 1 1/8 yards

Scraps or 1/8 yard cuts of blue, green, purple and pink.

Backing— 7/8 yard

Batting—crib size

Basic quilting supplies

Papers for Foundation Piecing



## Sentimental Stitches

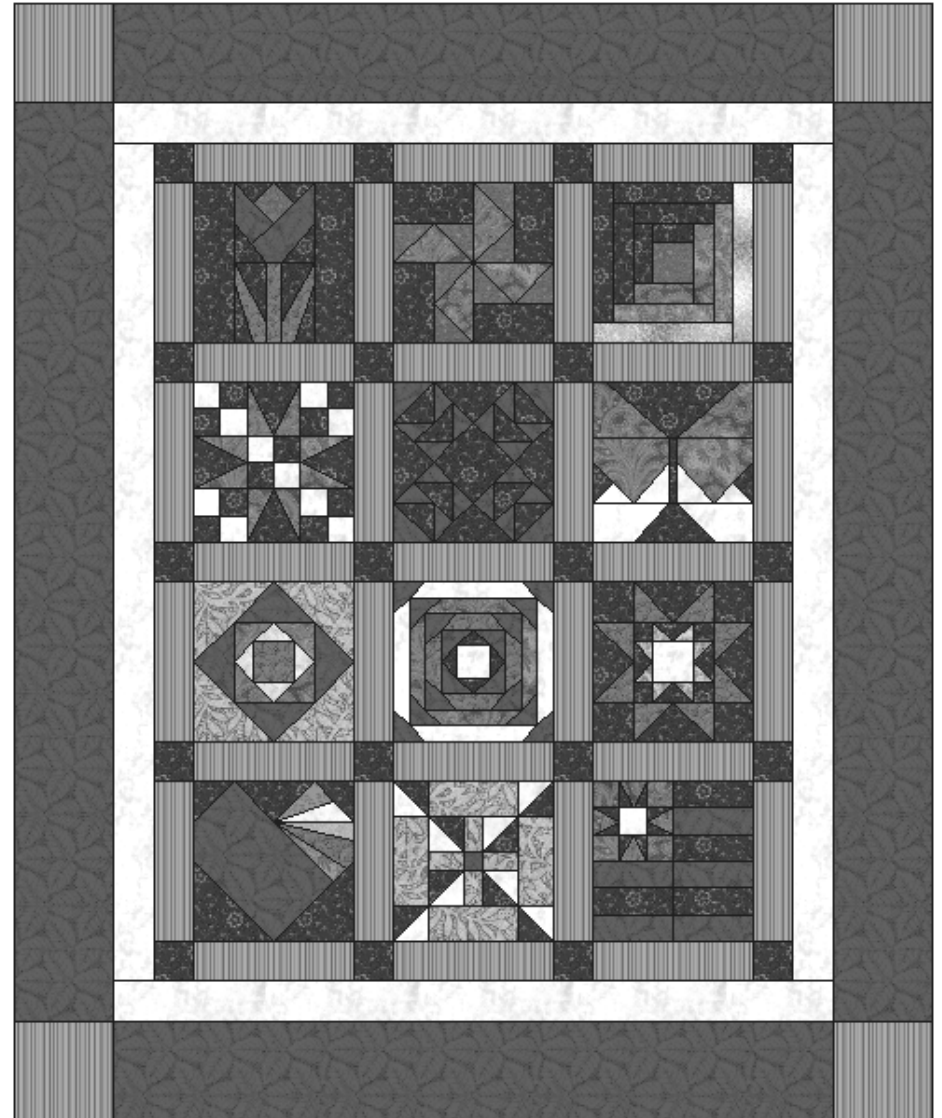

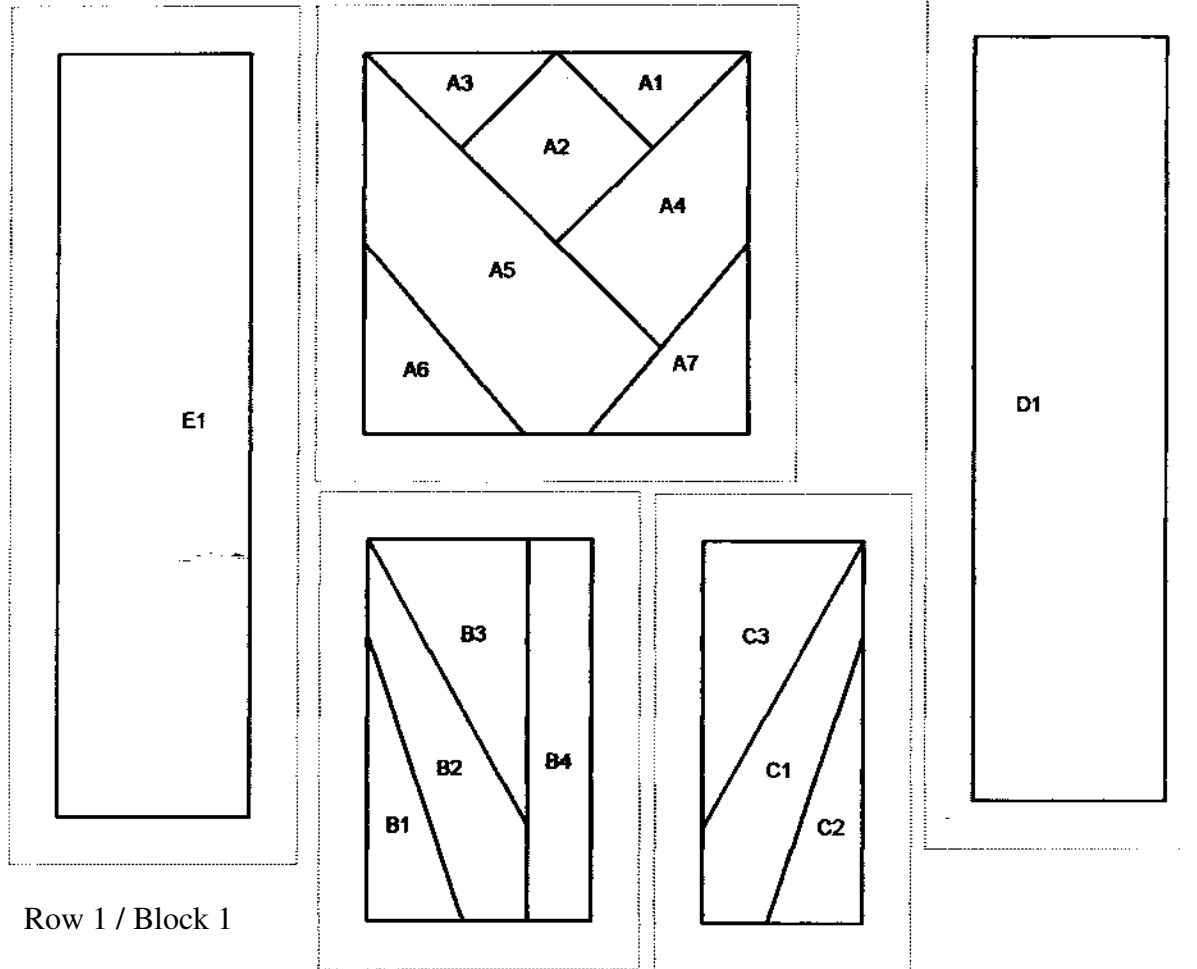

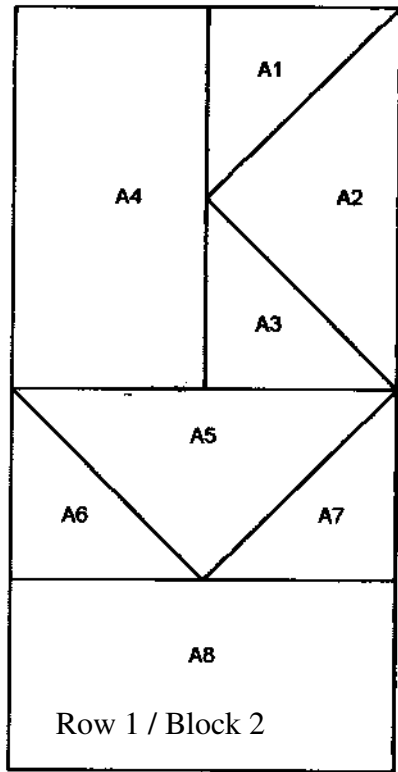
This pattern assumes you have basic quilting knowledge and basic foundation paper piecing knowledge.

1. From the enclosed foundation paper piecing patterns, make copies of twelve blocks on the foundation paper of your choice. My favorite paper is Foundation Piecing Papers from That Patchwork Place.
2. After foundation paper piecing your blocks, trim each to measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". The finished size of the blocks is 4"
3. From green sashing fabric—cut thirty one rectangles  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " and four 3" outer corner squares.
4. From black cornerstone fabric—cut twenty  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
5. From yellow inner border fabric—cut two side border strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25". Two top and bottom strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21".
6. From red outer border fabric—cut two side border pieces 3" x  $23\frac{1}{2}$ " and two top and bottom pieces 3" x  $18\frac{1}{2}$ ".
7. Piece blocks together with the sashing and cornerstones according to the diagram shown on the right.
8. Add the inner border.
9. Add the outer border with corner squares
10. Cut backing and batting 27" x 32". Layer backing, batting and top.
11. Quilt as desired. We just quilted "in the ditch" around the blocks.
12. Bind raw edges with single fold binding cut from background fabric. You'll need 3 strips cut  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x width of fabric.

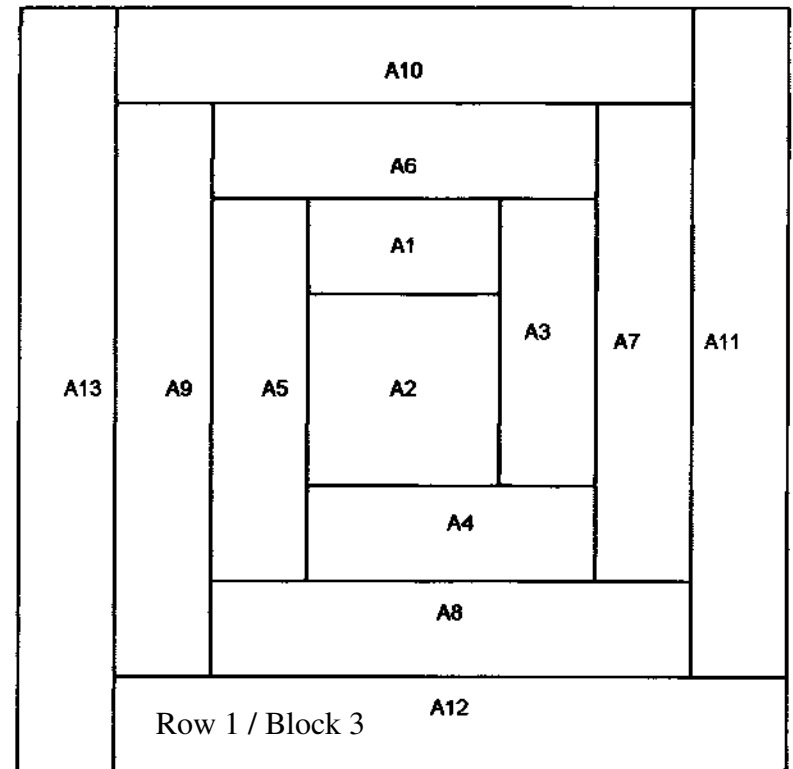
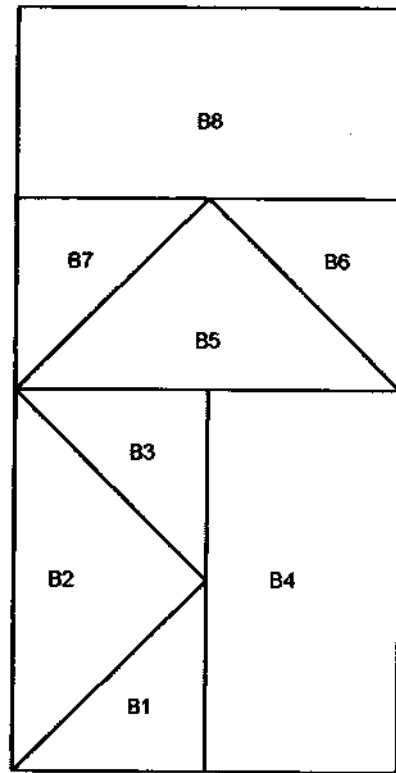




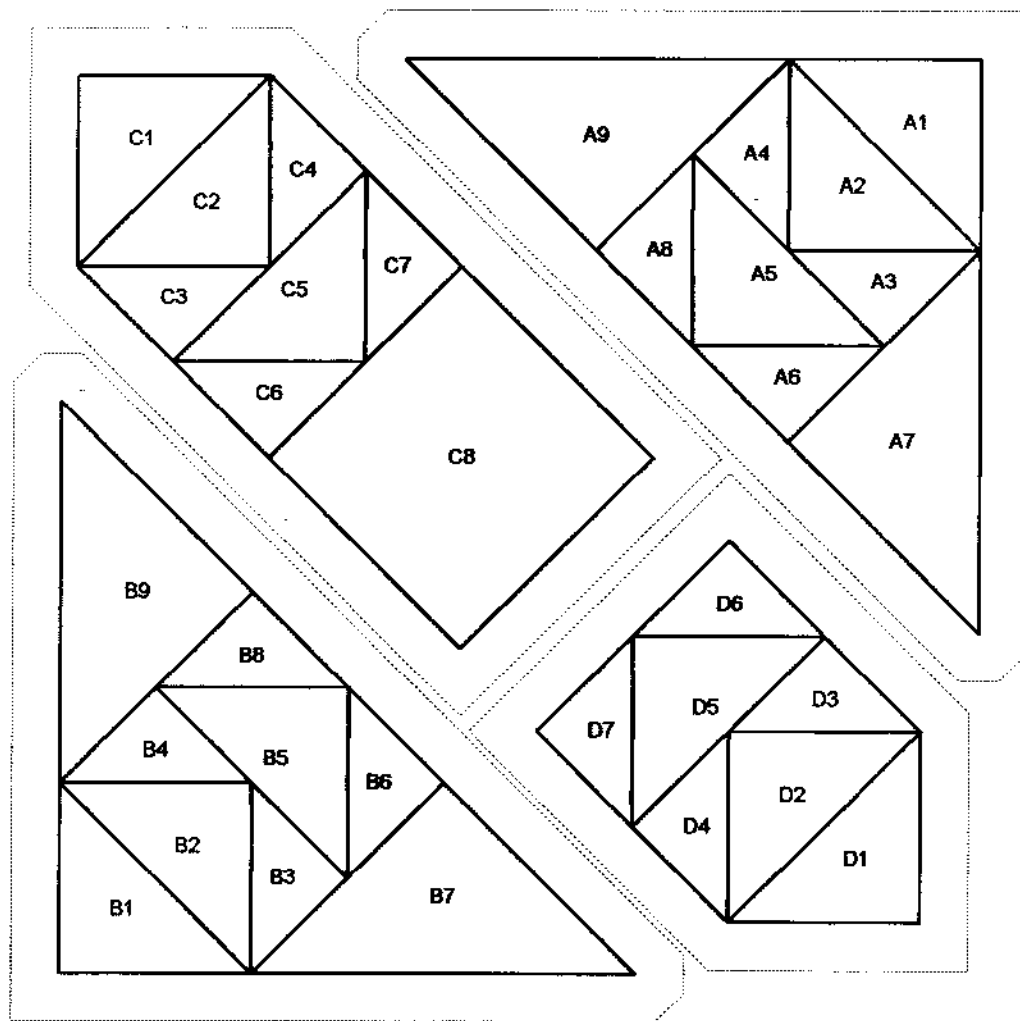
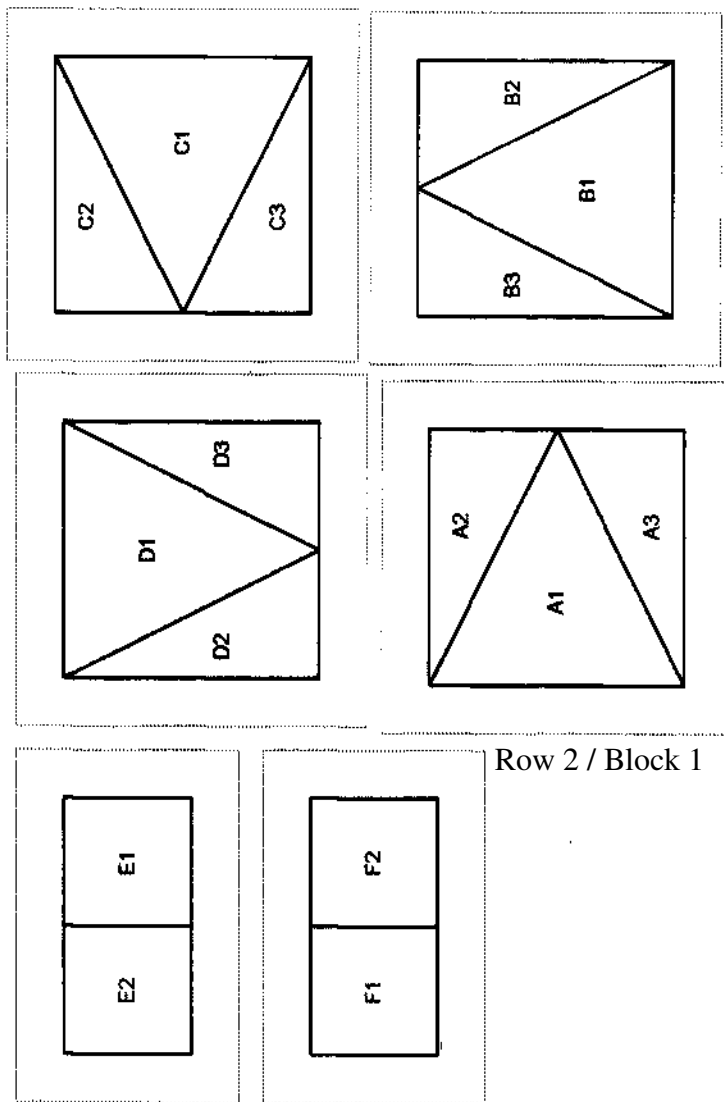

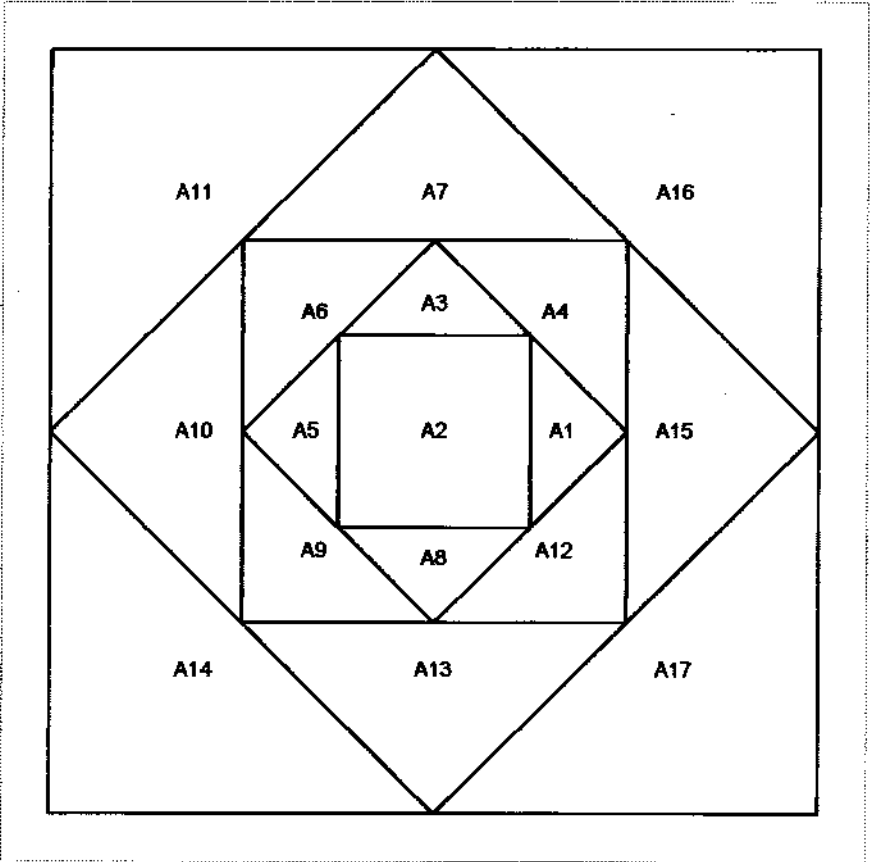
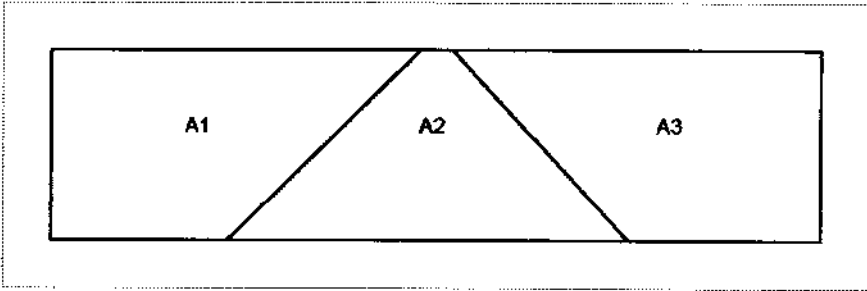
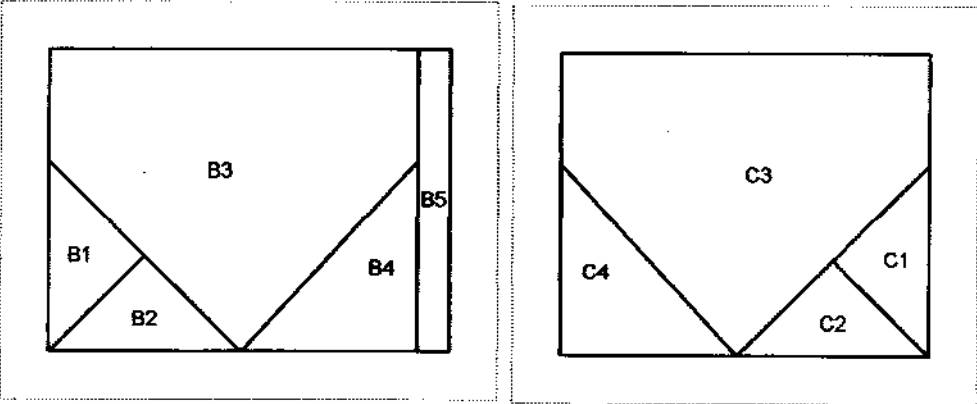
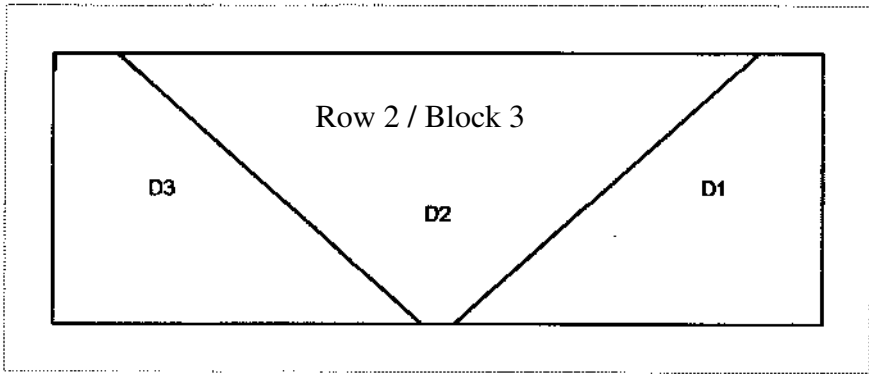


Row 1 / Block 2

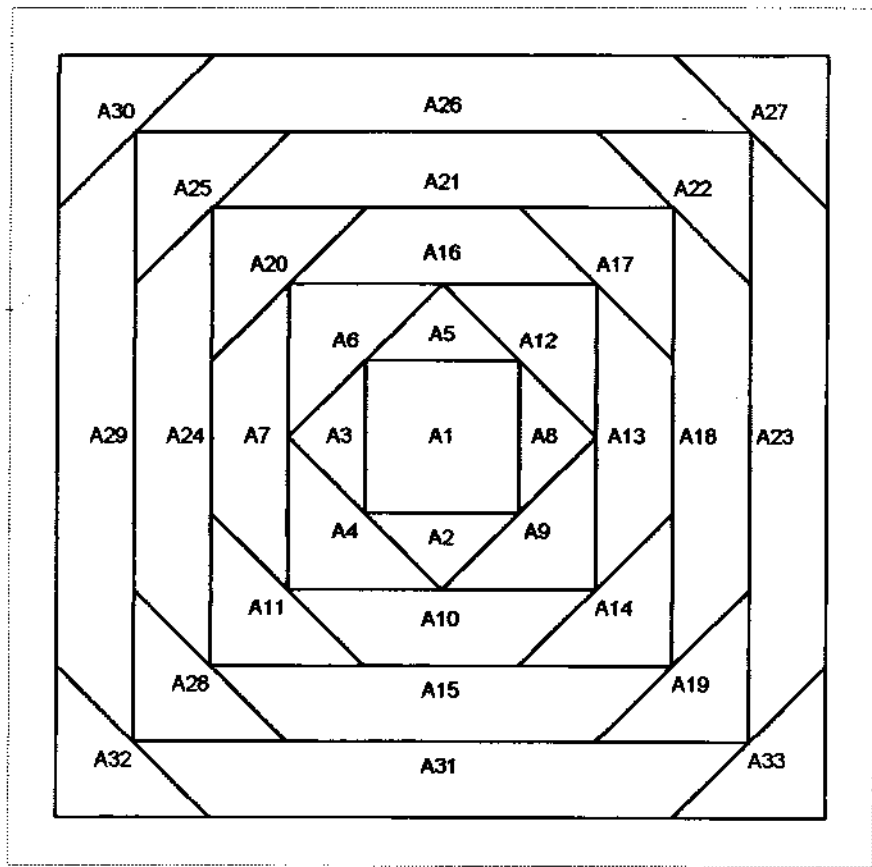
