## Midget Blocks-Block 100

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.
Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using medium pink, dark pink, light green, medium green solids and the background fabric.
I chose to use a print fabrics for my illustration.
Magnolia Bud-4 1/2"
In the antique quilt this block is the fourth block from the left in the fourteenth row.
This block is well suited for foundation piecing

## Fabrics-

If you have a fat $1 / 8$ th ( 9 " $\times 22$ ") of each color you'll have plenty for your foundation piecing

- Foundation piece sections $\mathbf{A}-\mathbf{B}-\mathbf{C}-\mathrm{D}-\mathbf{E}-\mathbf{F}-\mathbf{G}-\mathbf{H}$
- Sew section $\mathbf{H}$ to $\mathbf{C}$

- Sew section $\mathbf{E}$ to $\mathbf{F}$



Sections A \& B

- Sew section G to D

- Sew the five rows together to complete the block


Your unfinished block should measure 5"
