

Midget Blocks—Block 100

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Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using medium pink, dark pink, light green, medium green solids and the background fabric.

I chose to use a print fabrics for my illustration.

Magnolia Bud - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the fourth block from the left in the fourteenth row.


This block is well suited for foundation piecing

Fabrics-

If you have a fat 1/8th (9" x 22") of each color you'll have plenty for your foundation piecing

- Foundation piece sections A—B—C—D—E—F—G—H
- Sew section H to C


• Sew section E to F






Sections A & B

- Sew section G to D
- Sew the five rows together to complete the block





Your unfinished block should measure 5"




Sentimental StitchesTM

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This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.

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
