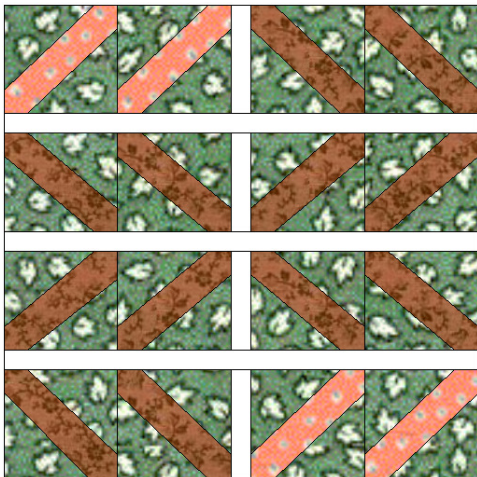


Midget Blocks—Block 102



Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a scrappy combination of orange and brown solids and a green print for the background fabric.

Indian Hatchet - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the eighth block from the left in the seventeenth row.

This block is well suited for a combination of foundation and machine piecing

Sashing fabric-

Cut three rectangles 5/8" x 5"

- This block has lots of small pieces and could be considered a miniature quilt so think of it that way as you assemble the block.
- Foundation piece the sixteen sections that make up the block. Your background fabric (green) can be all one fabric or different fabrics of the same color.

Make 1 like this

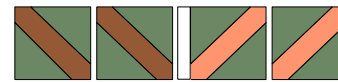
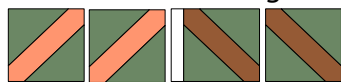


Make 3 like this

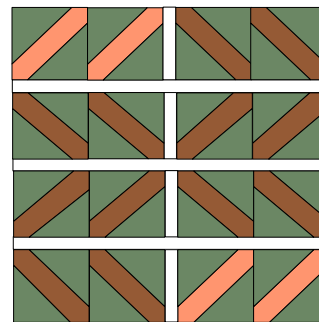
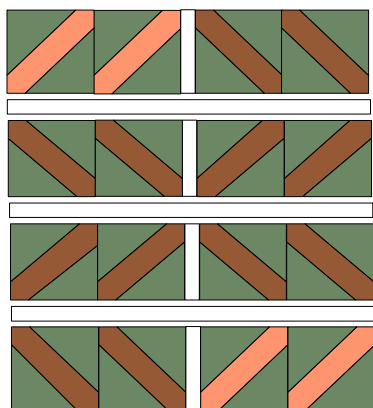


Make 9 like this

- Sew the sections together in rows



- Sew the rows together using the 5/8" x 5" sashing rectangles to complete the block



Your unfinished block should measure 5"



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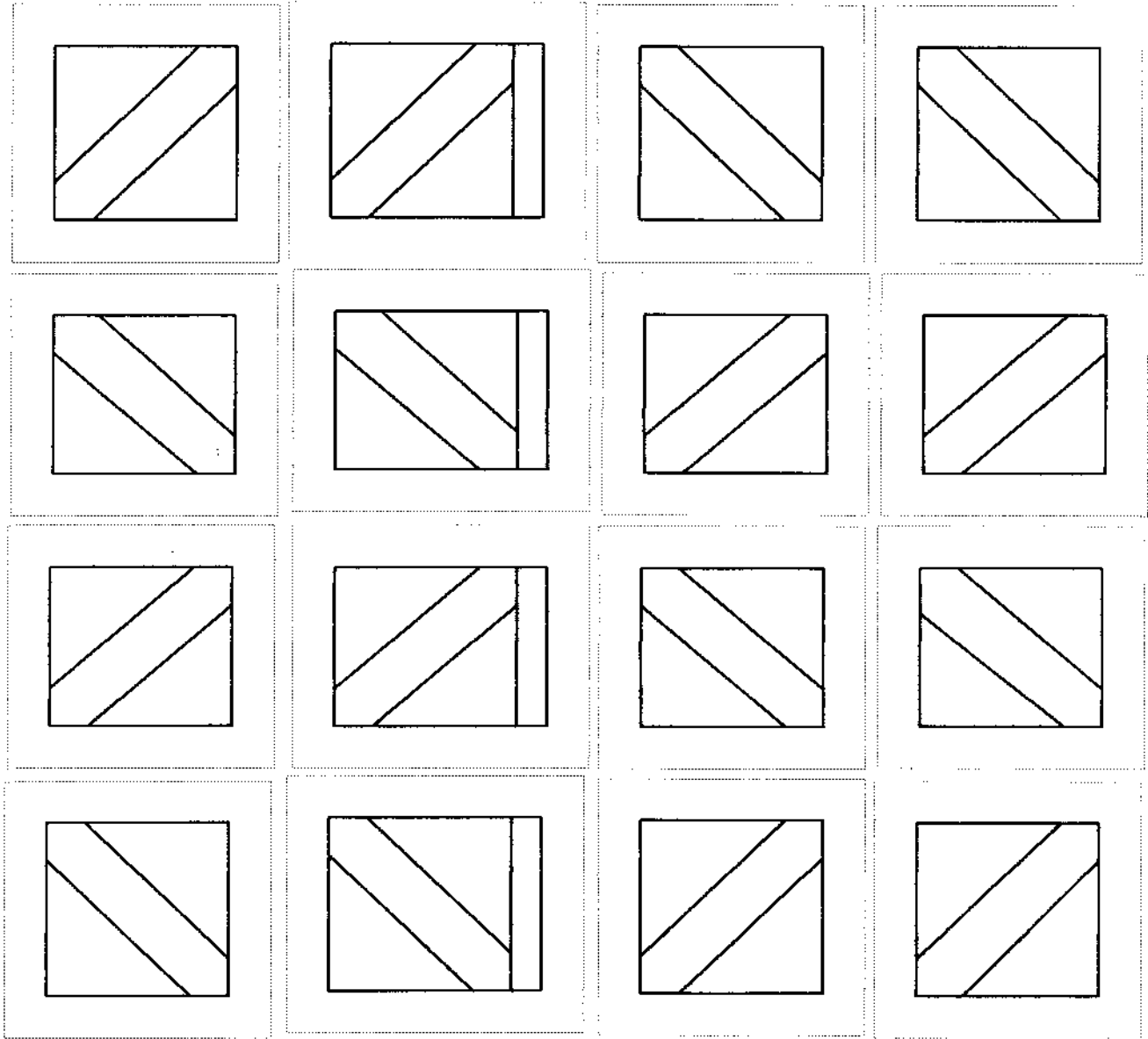

Indian Hatchet - 4 1/2"



Your unfinished block should measure 5"



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
