

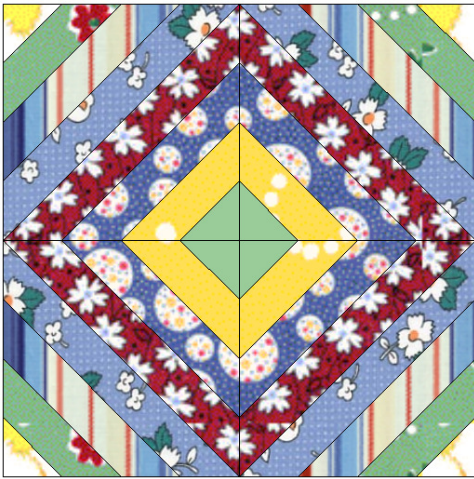
## Midget Blocks—Block 103

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own. Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a variety of prints in a somewhat planned way

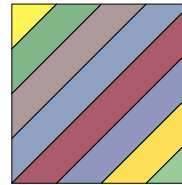
**String- 4 1/2"**

**In the antique quilt this block is the first block from the left in the thirteenth row.**

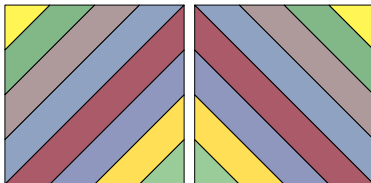
This block is well suited for foundation piecing



- Foundation piece the four sections that make up the block.
- Sew the sections together in rows

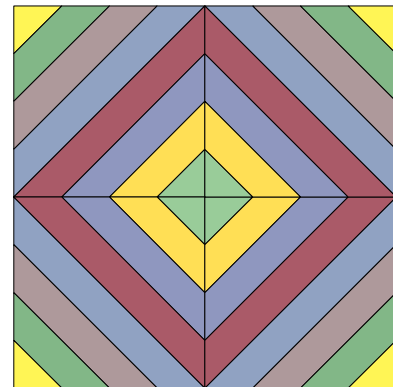
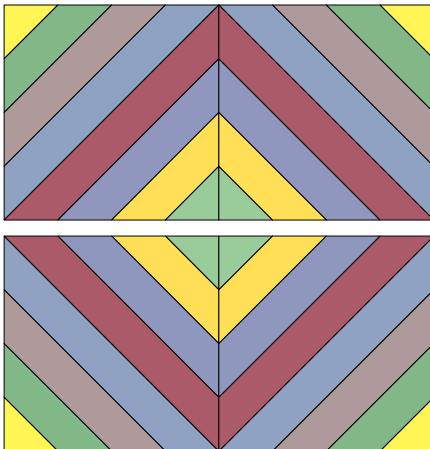


Make 4 like this

- Sew the rows together to complete the block

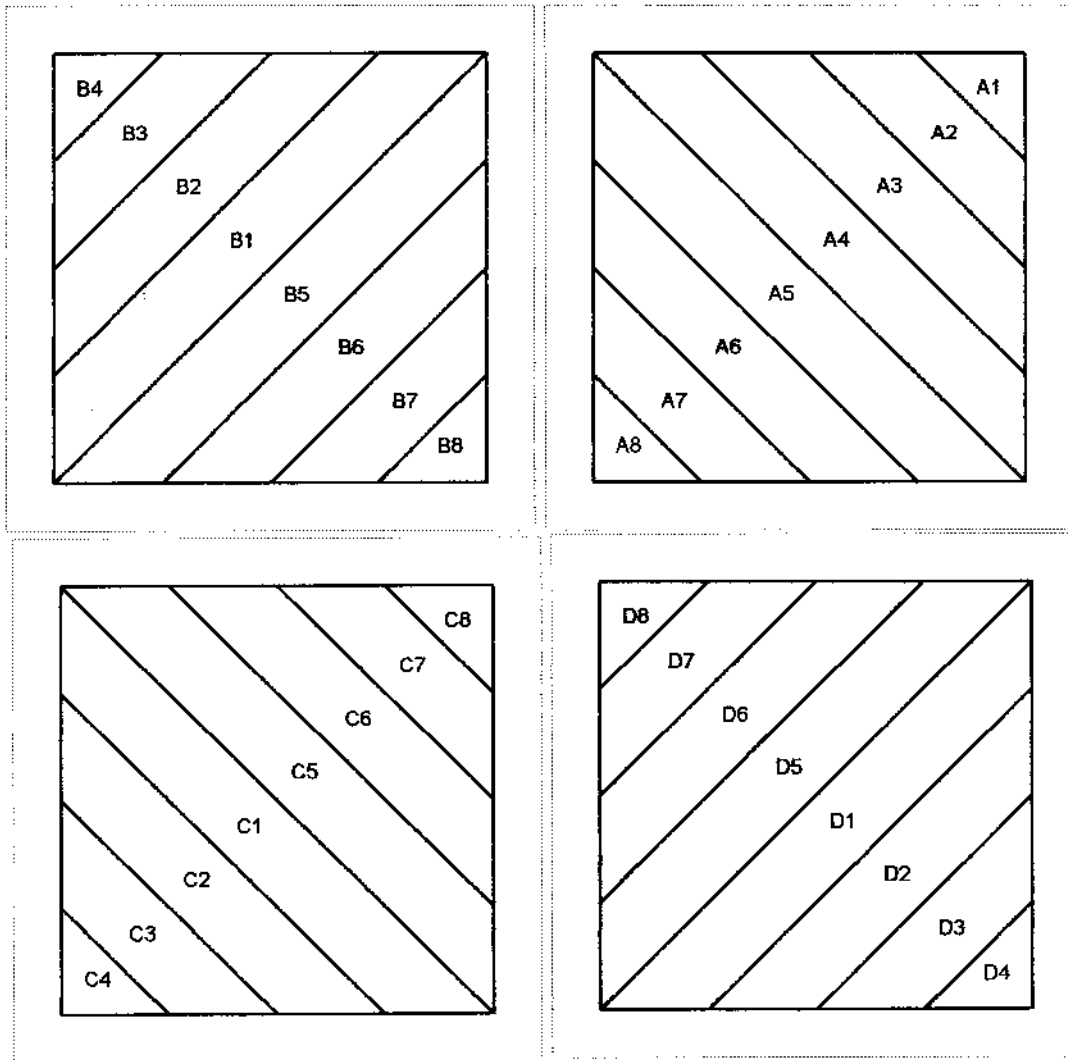
