## Midget Blocks-Block 103

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.
Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a variety of prints in a somewhat planned way

String-4 1/2"
In the antique quilt this block is the first block from the left in the thirteenth row.

This block is well suited for foundation piecing

- Foundation piece the four sections that make up the block.
- Sew the sections together in rows


Make 4 like this


Sew together 2 like this

- Sew the rows together to complete the block


Your unfinished block should measure 5"


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This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.
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
