

# Midget Blocks—Block 93

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a blue print, light blue solid and medium blue solid.

### Cross & Crown—4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the third block from the left in the seventeenth row.

This block is well suited for a combination of foundation and machine piecing

Your unfinished block should measure 5"


#### Blue print-


Cut 1 square 1 3/8"


#### Medium blue solid:


Cut 2 rectangles 1 3/8" x 2 1/4"


- Foundation paper piece the four sections of the block.
- Sew the sections together to form the two halves of the block.
- Sew a medium blue rectangle to opposite edges of the blue print square to form the center sashing strip.
- Sew one of the halves to each side of the center sashing strip to complete the block.













## Sentimental Stitches<sup>TM</sup>

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This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.

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
