

Midget Blocks—Block 98

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

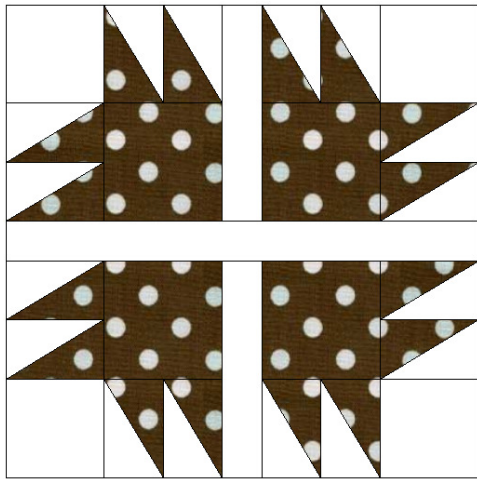
Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using brown solid and the background fabric.

I chose to use a print for my illustration.

Turkey Track - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the tenth block from the left in the thirteenth row.

This block is well suited for foundation and machine piecing



Fabrics-

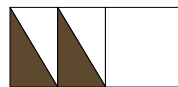
If you have a fat 1/8th (9" x 22") of each color you'll have plenty for your foundation piecing

Background fabric-

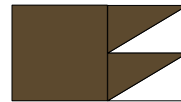
Cut one rectangle 7/8" x 5"

- Foundation piece sections A—C—E and G
- Foundation piece sections D and H
- Foundation piece sections B and F

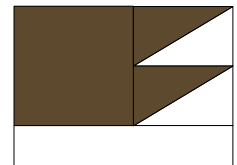
- Sew sections A to B and E to F
- Sew sections C to D and G to H



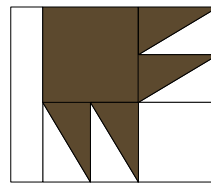
A—C—E—G



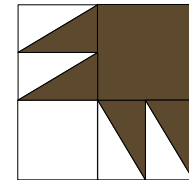
D—H



B—F

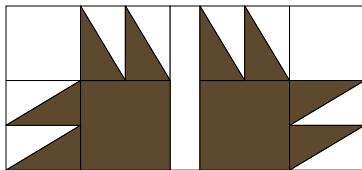


A to B & E to F



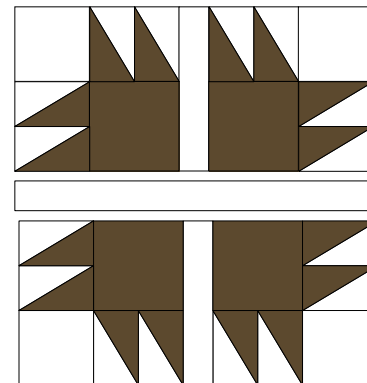
C to D & G to H

- Sew the four units together as shown for the top and bottom sections



- Sew the top and bottom sections to the 7/8" x 5" background strip to complete the block

Your unfinished block should measure 5"

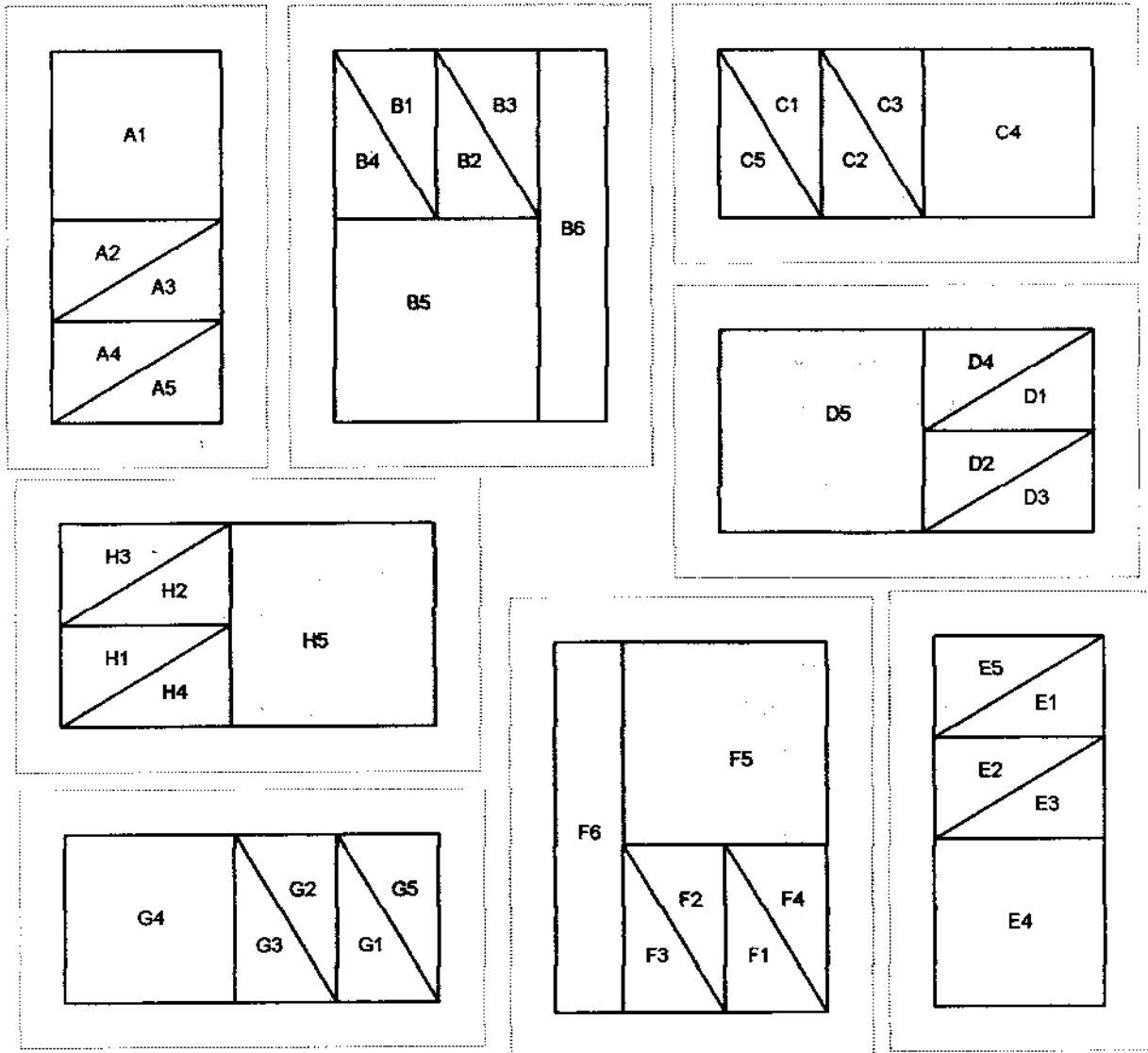
