

Midget Blocks—Block 106

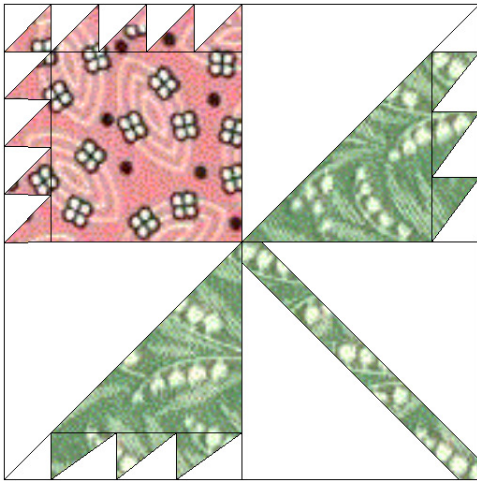
Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using pink solid, green solid and the background fabric.

English Ivy- 4 1/2"

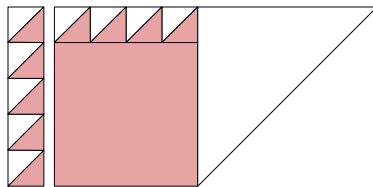
In the antique quilt this block is the seventh block from the left in the tenth row.

This block is well suited for foundation piecing

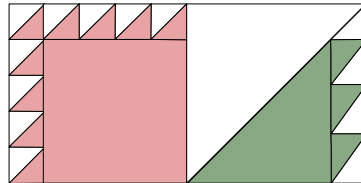


- Foundation piece units A through E

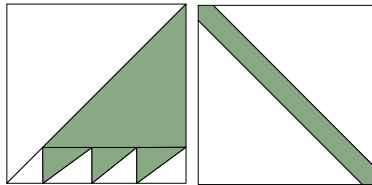
- Sew unit A to B



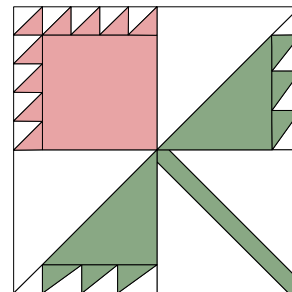
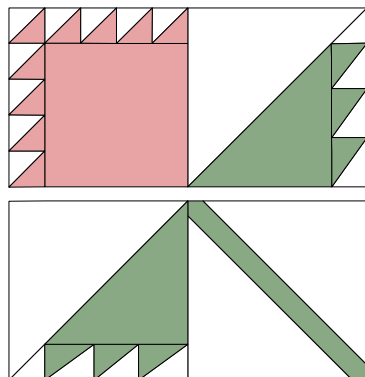
- Sew unit D to section A/B



- Sew units C to E



- Sew the two sections together across the middle seam to complete the block



Your unfinished block should measure 5"



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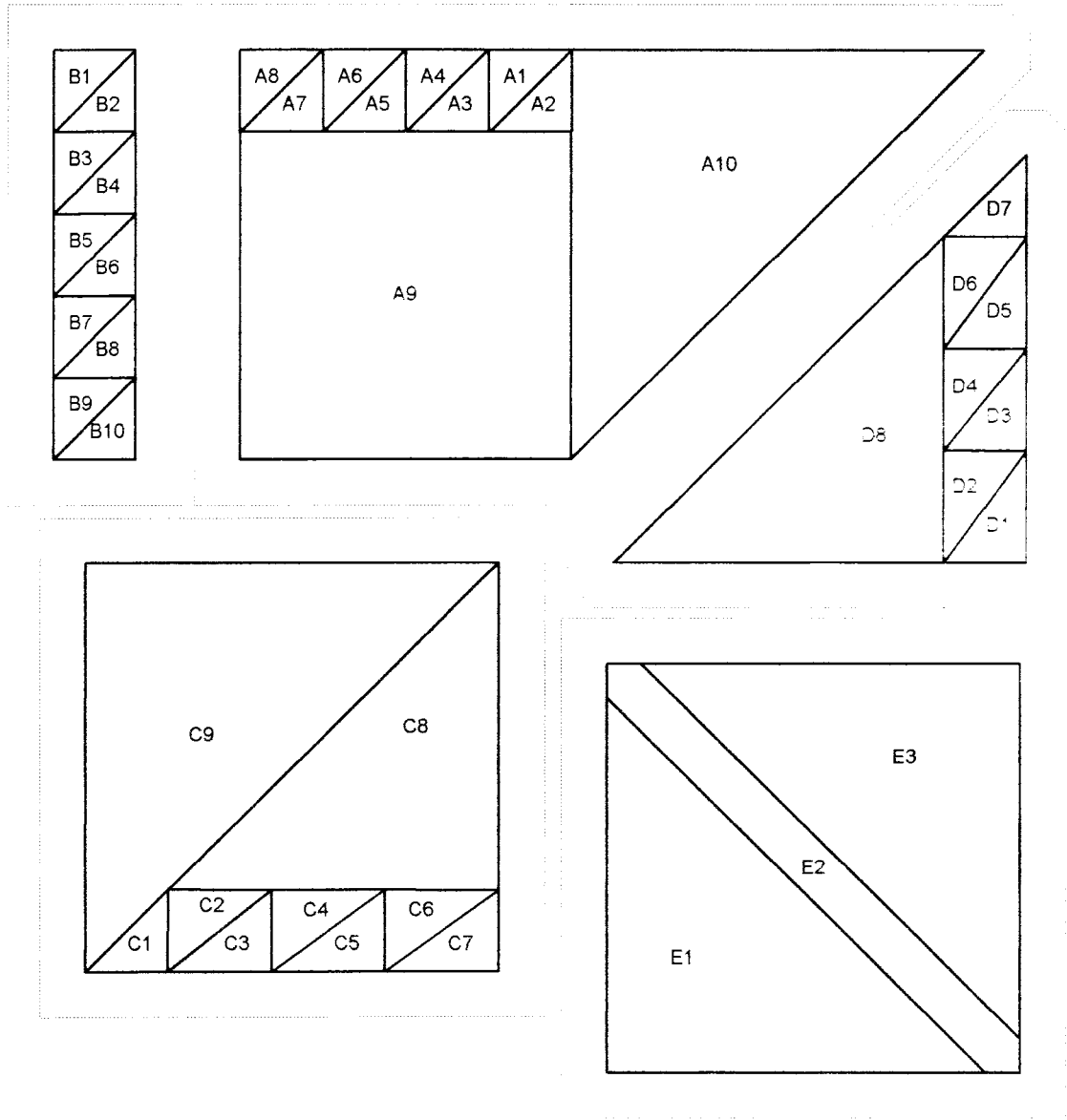
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This line should
