Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.


Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using pale yellow solid, lt. yellow solid, yellow print, multi-color print and the background fabric.


Garden Maze- 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the fourth block from the left in the sixteenth row.

This block is well suited for foundation piecing

Foundation piece units A through L








- Sew unit A to G / C to H / D to F and B to E
- Sew units I—J—K—L to the corners of each pair







Sew the quarter block sections together



• Sew the two sections together across the middle seam to complete the block





Your unfinished block should measure 5"




Sentimental StitchesTM
