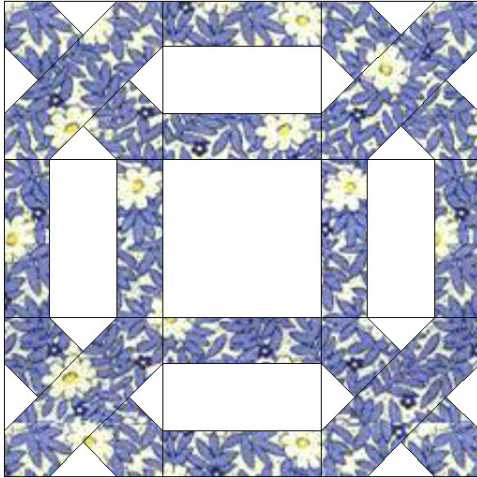


Midget Blocks—Block 116

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own. Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using blue print fabric and the background fabric.

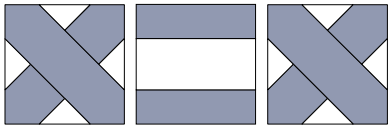
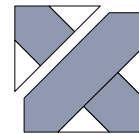
Garden Maze- 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the fifth block from the left in the first row.

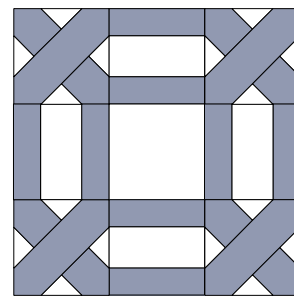
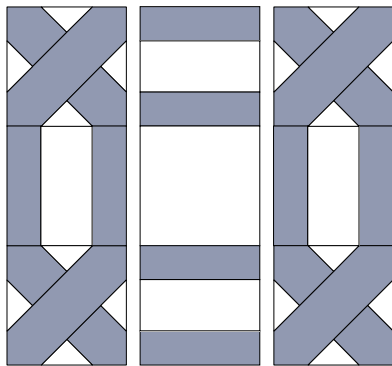


This block is well suited for foundation piecing

- Foundation piece units A through J
- Sew unit F to C, K to D, H to E and J to B for corner sections of block.
- Sew square C/F to top of unit G. Sew square D/K to bottom of unit G



- Repeat with squares B/J and E/H sewing to unit I
- Sew these two sections to each side of unit A to complete the block.



Your unfinished block should measure 5"

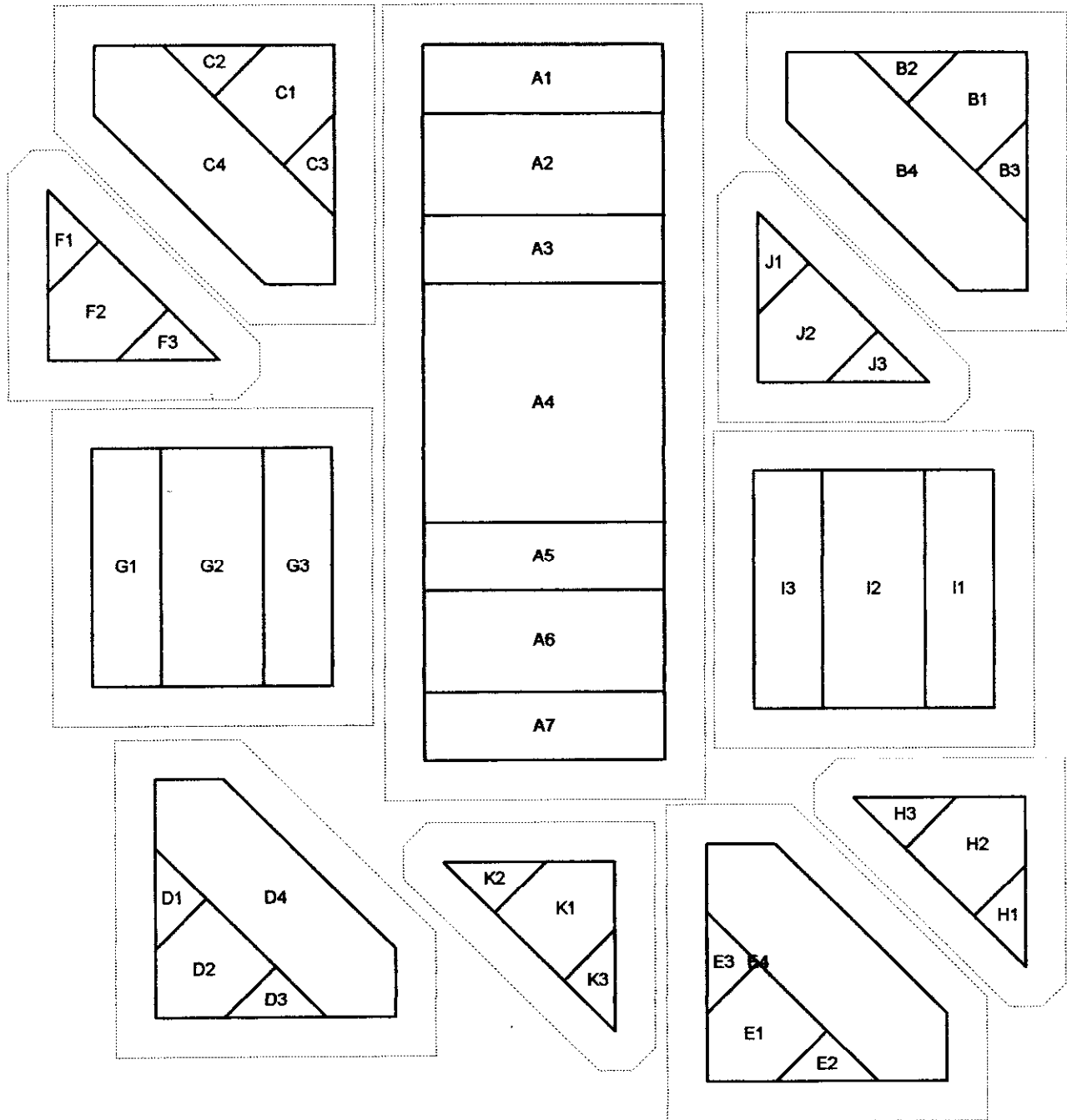
