

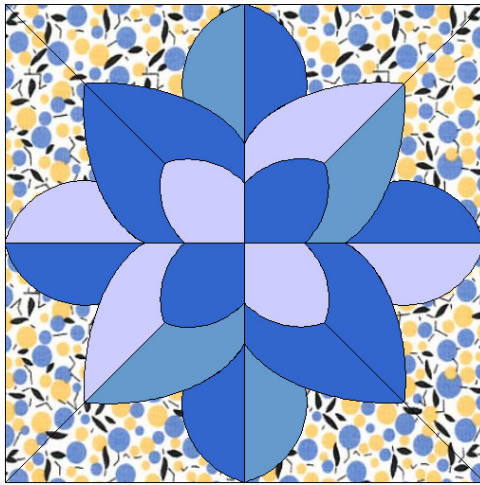
## Midget Blocks—Block 119

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own. Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a light, medium and dark blue solid and a print background fabric.

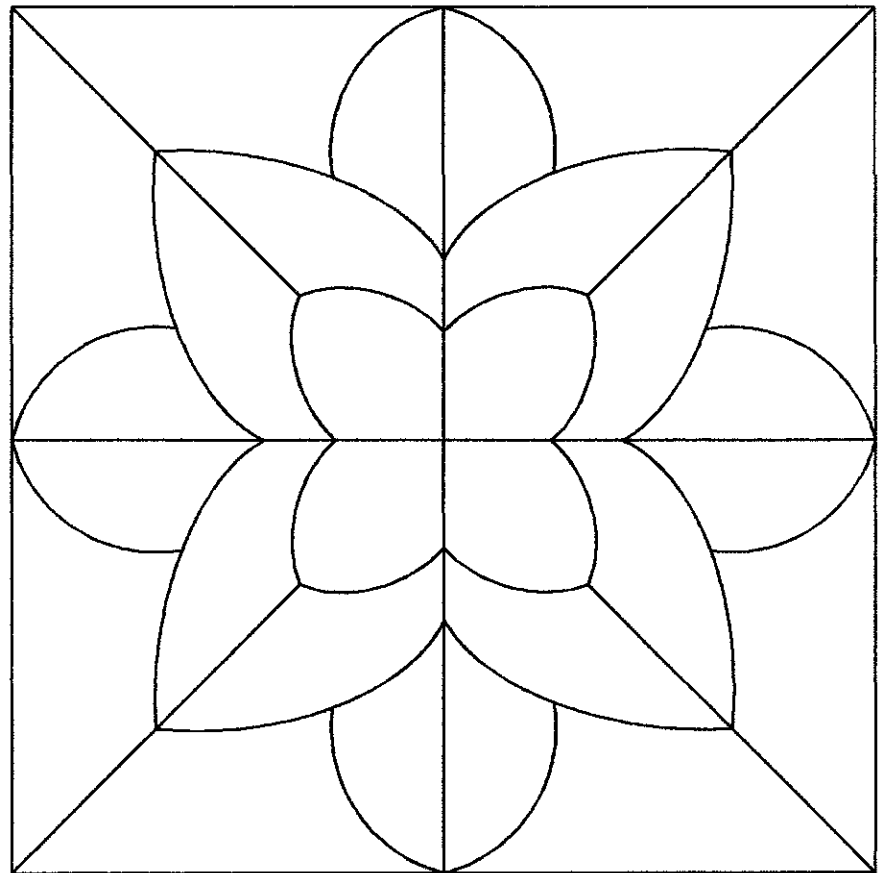
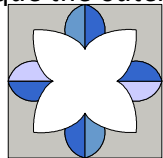
### Carolina Favorite- 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the second block from the left in the tenth row.

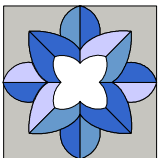
This block is well suited for hand or machine applique



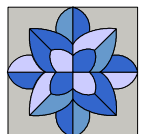
- From background fabric cut one 5" square.
- Cut two 1 1/4" x 2" rectangles light blue
- Cut two 1 1/4" x 2" rectangles medium blue
- Cut four 1 1/4" x 2" rectangles dark blue
- Cut one 3" square light blue and cut diagonally one way to yield two triangles
- Cut one 3" square medium blue and cut diagonally one way to yield two triangles
- Cut two 3" squares dark blue
- Cut two 1 1/2" squares dark blue
- Cut two 1 1/2" squares light blue
- Sew light and medium blue rectangles to dark blue rectangles along 2" edge. Use a small stitch length for secure seams. Press seams open. Use these units to appliqué the outer petals.



- Sew light and medium blue triangles together along the long edges. Press seams open. Sew these triangle units to dark blue squares forming a four patch unit. Use this unit to appliqué the diagonal petal unit. You can easily release a couple of machine stitches at the inner curves to turn under the edges of your appliqué.



- Sew the 1 1/2" squares together in a four patch block. Press seams open. Use this to appliqué the center four petals completing the block.



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Your unfinished block should measure 5"

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This line should measure 1" after printing pattern.
