

## Midget Blocks—Block 120




Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using a blue solid and a background fabric.


## **Double T- 4 1/2"**


In the antique quilt this block is the seventh block from the left in the fourteenth row.
