

Midget Blocks—Block 124

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own. Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using pink solid and the background fabric.

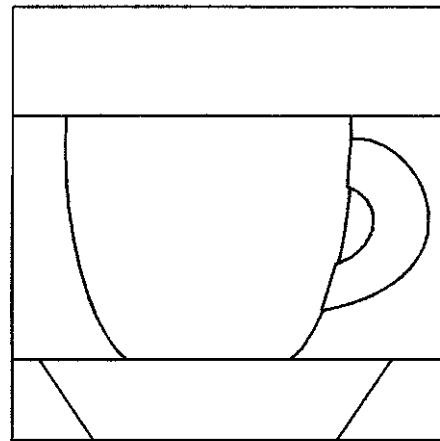
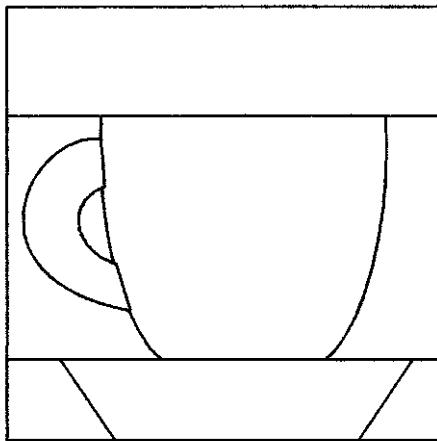
Coffee Cups- 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the first block from the left in the fourteenth row.

This block is well suited for foundation piecing and applique

- The center section of the block is where you'll appliqué the cup and handle.
- I cut four pieces of background fabric 3" x 4" (I know it's larger than necessary) and appliquéed a handle and cup on each piece.
- Two of the cups have the handle facing to the left and two are facing to the right.
- After completing your appliqué, foundation piece the lower section of each cup.
- You should be able to match your appliquéed cup to it's respective section on the paper piecing pattern and finish assembling the block.

Your unfinished block should measure 5"

printing pattern.

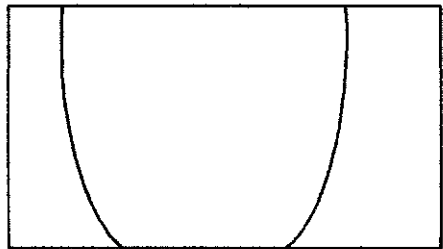
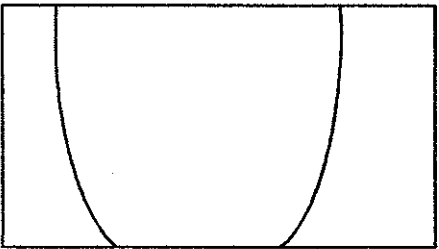
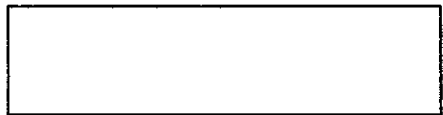
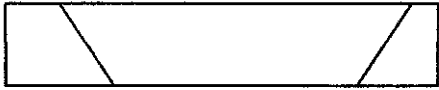
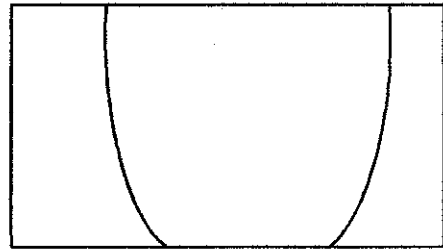
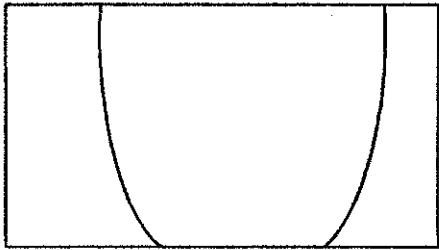
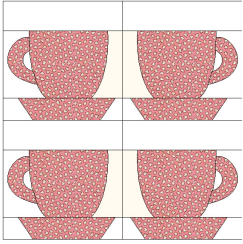
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
