

SHIPSHEWANA AMISH QUILT Sections Assembly

- Sew unit B to unit C.
- Sew units B / C to unit A.
- Sew unit D to units B / C / A.
- Sew unit E to unit F.
- Sew units E / F to unit G.
- The final seam goes across the center of the quilt

joining the A / B / C / D unit to the E / F / G units.

Please measure your center section vertically and horizontally the edges and down the center to determine the length your border strips should be cut. If the edges are a different measurement than the center one, use an average. ie. Edges measure 24", center measures 22", cut border 23" plus seam allowance. Measurements listed below are based on mathematical calculations & include a 1/4" seam allowance.



Inner border:

Cut two strips 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" for the sides. Cut two strips 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" for the top and bottom.

* depending on the yardage purchased you may have to sew together strips cut 1 1/2" x width of your fabric end to end in order to achieve the length needed.

Outer border:

Cut two strips 6 1/2" x 56 1/2" for the sides. Cut two strips 6 1/2" x 56 1/2" for the top and bottom.

Sew border strips to center unit in the same order they were cut.

Backing:

Cut 3 3/4 yard piece of backing fabric in half and sew the 67 1/2" pieces together crosswise.

Binding:

You will need inches 250" of binding cut 2 1/4" wide.

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
