

## Sally Post Floral Sampler Quilt

Appliqué background fabric: $13 / 4$ yards

Sashing:
Cornerstones:
Block triangles:

3 1/8 yards
3/4 yard
2 yards

Appliqué fabrics: the antique quilt was made with mostly solid color fabrics of red, green and cheddar. There are a few small scale prints used and you'll be able to see those in the individual block patterns. The quiltmaker did use the same green solid for all of the blocks. If you'd like to do the same, l'd recommend purchasing 2 yards of that fabric. The block triangles appear to be the same at first glance but there were two fabrics used. Sadly the dye in one of the red fabrics deteriorated and only holes remain in its place.

## Cutting

Appliqué blocks Cut 36 squares 8 1/2". After completing your appliqué, trim these blocks to $75 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square.

Sashing
Cornerstones: Cut 84 rectangles $4 " \times 101 / 2 "$ ( $1 / 4$ " seam allowance included) Cut 49 squares 4 "
Block triangles: Cut 72 squares 6 " and cut in half diagonally to yield 144 triangles.
