Cutting for Center Diamond Block:

1/4" seam allowance is included in all cutting measurements. Finished size of block—12"

Green fabric-

Cut one 3 5/8" square.

Black fabric-

Cut four rectangles $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut four rectangles 1 3/8" x 3 5/8".

Blue fabric-

Cut four rectangles 2" x 9 1/2"

Cut four 1 3/8" squares.

Cranberry fabric-

Cut two 4 3/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles.

Cut four 1 1/2" squares.

Cut four 2" squares.

Piecing of Block:



Sew two of the smaller black rectangles to opposite sides of green square.




Sew blue squares to opposite ends of remaining small black rectangles. Sew to opposite sides of green square.



Sew a cranberry triangle to each side of center square unit.




Sew two of the larger black rectangles to opposite sides of center unit.




Sew cranberry squares to opposite ends of remaining large black rectangles. Sew to opposite sides of center unit.



Sew two blue rectangles to opposite sides of you're the pieced square.



Sew cranberry squares to opposite ends of remaining blue rectangles. Sew to opposite sides of square to complete the block.



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
