Cutting:

1/4" seam allowance is included in all cutting measurements. Finished size of block—12"

Brown fabric-

- Cut one 4 3/4" square
- Cut one 7 1/4" square and cut diagonally both ways to yield
- Cut eight 2 3/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 16 triangles
- Cut two 3 7/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles



- Cut four 2" squares
- Cut twelve 2 3/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 24 triangles
- Cut two 3 7/8" squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles

Piecing:



Sew a small (2 3/8") triangle to each of the small brown triangles.



Sew the half-square triangles in pairs.

Sew the remaining black triangles to the half-square triangle pairs.




black square to the end of four of the half-square triangle units.
