## SHIPSHEWANA AMISH QUILT Section 6

## Cutting:

1/4" seam allowance is included in all cutting measurements.
Finished size of block-12"
Brown fabric-

- Cut one $43 / 4$ " square
- Cut one $71 / 4$ " square and cut diagonally both ways to yield 4 triangles
- Cut eight $23 / 8$ " squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 16 triangles
- Cut two $37 / 8$ " squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles

Black fabric-

- Cut four 2" squares
- Cut twelve $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 24 triangles
- Cut two $37 / 8$ " squares and cut diagonally one way to yield 4 triangles


## Piecing:



Sew a small (2 $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ ) triangle to each of the small brown triangles.


Sew the half-square triangles in pairs.


black square to the end of four of the half-square triangle units.


Sew the remaining half-square triangle units to the four triangles cut from the $71 / 4$ " square.



Sew a black triangle to each side of the center square



Sew one of the pieced half-square triangle units to each side of the center unit to complete the block. Your square should measure 12 1/2"
