

Midget Blocks—Block 110

Midget Blocks are a series of wonderful little blocks adapted from an antique sampler quilt made during the 1930s. I hope you'll enjoy making these blocks and a sampler quilt of your own.

Most of these blocks were made using just two colors. A print or solid color and the background fabric. This block in the original quilt was constructed using brown solid and the pink solid background fabric.

Arrowhead - 4 1/2"

In the antique quilt this block is the second block from the left in the seventh row.

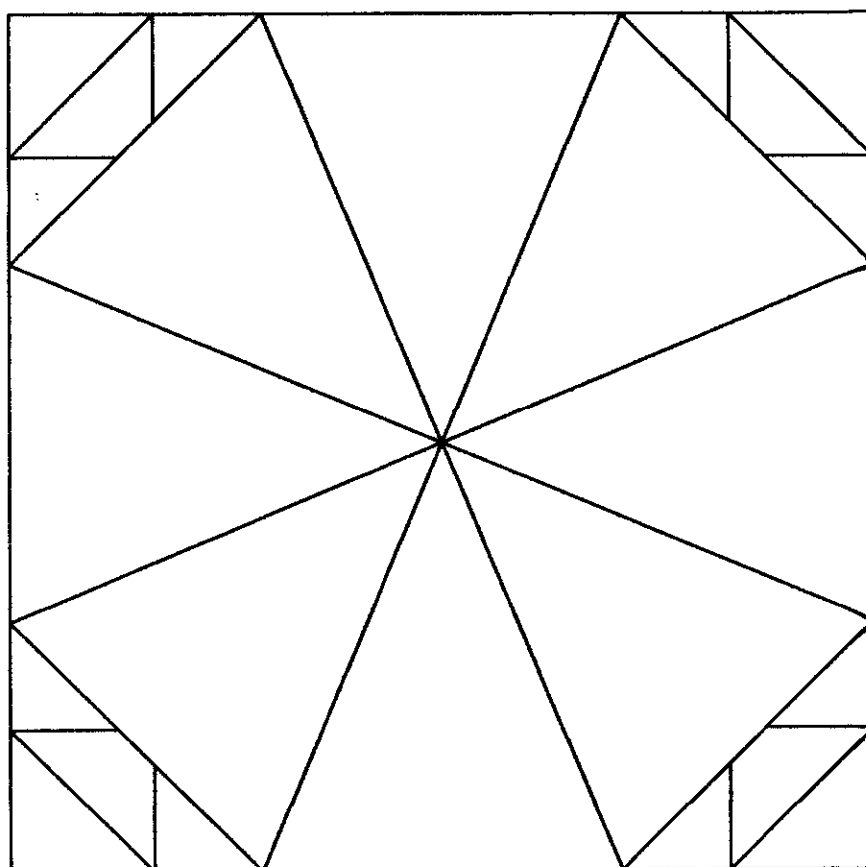
This block is well suited for applique

Background fabric—

Cut one 6" square. Trim to 5" after your appliqué is completed

Applique fabric — scrap pieces

- Applique the block using your favorite hand or machine method



Your unfinished block should measure 5"
