Quilt Notes



- There are 20 appliqued blocks in the quilt. Each one is a different flower with embroidery details.
- There are 12 embroidered blocks in the quilt. They are all the same flower but the design varies a little from block to block. The floss colors used are the same in each block.
- The embroidery on the appliqued blocks is worked using one strand of floss rather than the usual two strands.
- The only print fabric in the quilt is in the Tiger Lily block.
- All of the fabrics are cotton. The backing is the same creamy white solid color used for the background.
- The binding is the green solid used in the applique border. It's a traditional bias binding just over 1/4" wide.
- The applique blocks are outlined quilted around the flower. The border is quilted around the applique vine. There's a meandering feather design toward the outside edge with a feather/flower design in the corners. The remainder of the quilt is filled with 1" crosshatch quilting. A thin cotton batting was used.
- Finished size of the blocks is 7 1/2"
- Finished width of the border is 15"
- Finished size of the quilt is 73 1/2" x 83"


Dream Garden Cutting Instructions


Background fabric

- Cut thirty two 9" squares. Trim to 8" after applique and embroidery. Finished size of blocks is 7 1/2"
- Cut four 12" squares. Cut diagonally in both directions to yield 16 setting triangles. (you'll use 14)
- Cut two 6 1/4" squares. Cut diagonally in one direction to yield 4 corner triangles.
- Cut border strips 15 1/2" wide. Cut two strips for the sides 94" long. Cut two strips for the top and bottom 84". Extra length has been added to allow for mitering the corners. **Finished width of the border is 15"**

Embroidery reference -

• The embroidery stitches shown below were used in various places throughout the quilt. The stitches used on individual blocks will be noted on the pattern pages.





Finished size of blocks is 7 1/2"

Finished width of border is 15"
